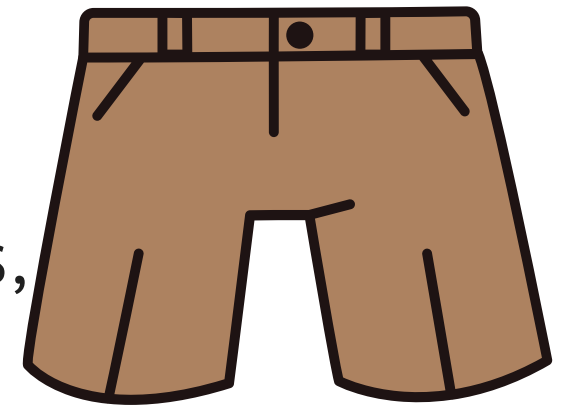
## CATECHESIS OF THE GOOD SHEPHERD AD

**CLICK FOR FULL SCRIP AGREEMENT**

ST. BONIFACE PARISH SCRIP PROGRAM AGREEMENT

allows you to purchase scrip cards from participating retailers. These cards generate rebates for our parish. Families can decide where 50% of the rebates they earn will be applied. If no choice is made, the total goes to the general fund. Grandparents and friends can also sign up to give 50% to another family (i.e. for tuition, etc.). Anyone may sign up for scrip online but for the distribution this form must be filled out and returned to the parish office for the scrip coordinator to enter. (sgres@wvhs.org)

REBATES EARNED WILL BE USED IN THE FOLLOWING WAYS:

- 10% will be retained by the scrip program for running cost (shipping/handling, paper, etc.).
- 40% will go to St. Boniface Parish General Fund.
- 50% will go to a contribution to ONE of the following:
  - TUITION CREDITS FOR THE FOLLOWING WCS FAMILY: (Please list the name of the family) \_\_\_\_\_

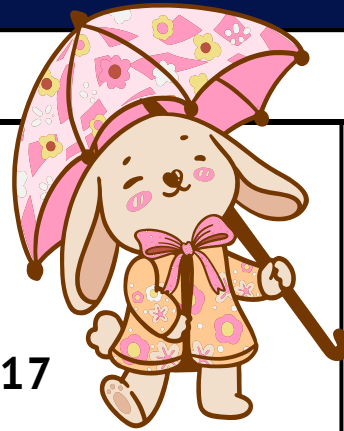
