Keep the sign ups coming!

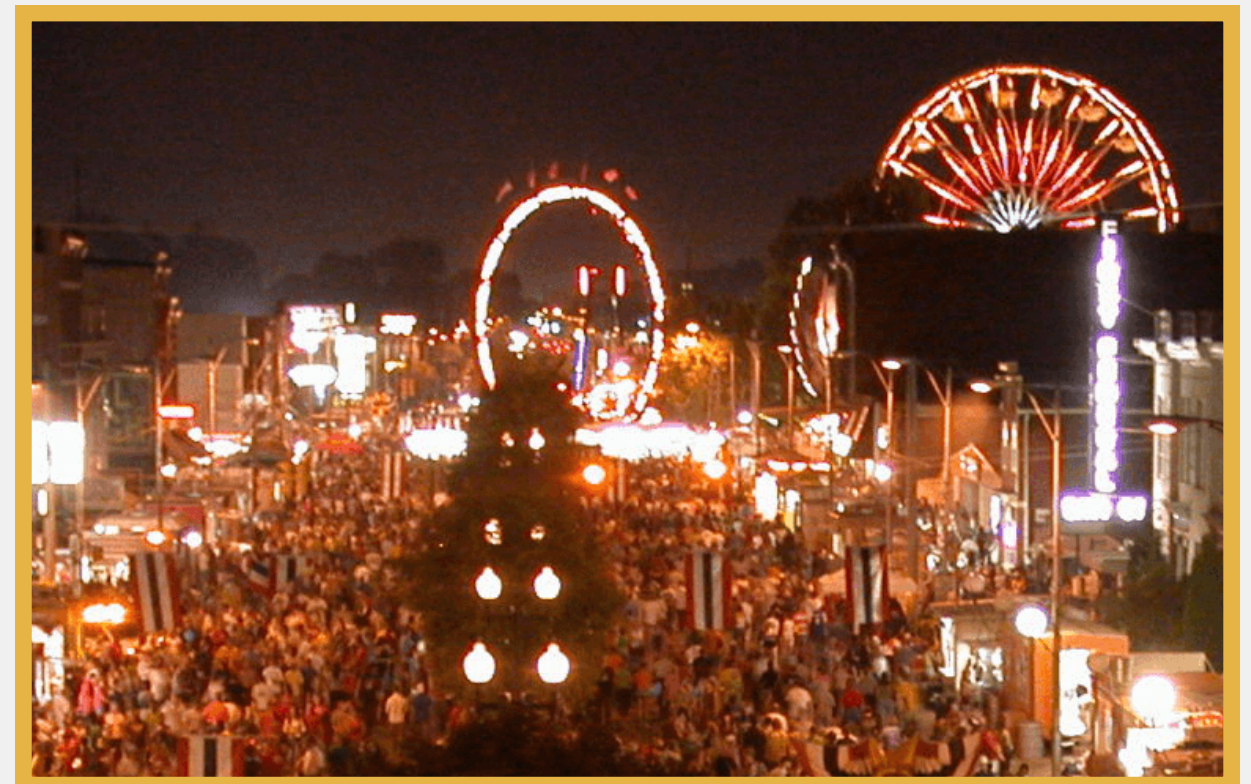
