Old Business:

- **Life and Justice:** On Saturday, September 13, from 9am to 12, there will be a gathering of Diocese speakers regarding "Caring for Creation". Forty people have signed up to attend.
- Diocesan Reconfiguration: Nothing to report.
- 50 year Anniversary of the Church of the Resurrection: The festivities will commence with the Bishop celebrating Mass at 4:00p.m., followed by the unveiling and blessing of the portrait of the Blessed Mother. An elegant dinner will be served in Immaculata Hall, cost of \$75 per person. Tim Flarety will provide the music. The KofC Women's Auxiliary will purchase blue and white table clothes for the parish to use.
- Reconfiguring of Church Entrance: Father Piotr will meet with the company representatives regarding fund raising for the entrance project for the Church of the Resurrection. This meeting will include the Financial/Stewardship report as well as information regarding the Capital Campaign.
