ORDINANCE NO.366

TAX LEVY ORDINANCE 2025

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LEVYING, ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTION OF TAXES FOR THE YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2026 AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2026.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF PARK COMMISSIONERS, LINCOLN PARK DISTRICT, LOGAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

SECTION 1

That a tax in the sum of Six Hundred Seventy-Eight Thousand, Three Hundred Eighty-Five Dollars (\$678,385.00) or as much thereof as may be authorized by law to defray all expenses and liabilities for all corporate purposes, for the purpose of planning, establishing and maintaining recreational programs, for participation in the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund, for liability expense, for purposes of audit expense, for the recreation and community center, for the purpose of paving and lighting of roadways within the parks and playgrounds maintained by the Park District, for the purpose of organizing and maintaining a police system within the parks and playgrounds, be and the same is hereby levied on all taxable property within the Lincoln Park District subject to taxation in the current tax year, and in the amounts so required or hereafter itemized as follows:

SECTION 2

That a bond for the Lincoln Park District shall be filed in the office of the Logan County Clerk as provided by law with a bond payment amount in this levy of Eight Hundred, Fifty-Four Thousand Dollars (\$854,000.00).

SECTION 3

That the County Clerk of Logan County, Illinois, be and is hereby authorized and instructed to levy a separate tax in addition to the amount authorized to be levied for all corporate purposes, for each and every items in Section 1 of the Ordinance that is a Special Tax Levy in accordance with those certain provisions of the ILLINOIS PARK DISTRICT CODE and other applicable statutes authorizing such additional taxes.

SECTION 4

That the secretary of the Board of Commissioners be and is hereby directed to file with the County Clerk, Logan County, Illinois, the levy and bond ordinances by the last Tuesday in December 2025 as required by law.

SECTION 5

That if any section, subdivision, or sentence of this Ordinance for any reason be held invalid or to be unconstitutional, such finding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this ordinance.

SECTION 6

That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage provided by law.

I, Donald Peasley, hereby certify that I am the presiding officer of the Lincoln Park District, as such presiding officer I certify that the 2026 Tax Levy Ordinance, a copy of which is attached hereto, was adopted pursuant to and in respects in compliance with the provisions of Section 18-60 through 18-85 of the "Truth in Taxation" Law. Choose one below (X):

1 1) The taxing district published a notice in the newspaper and or posted as required by law and conducted a hearing meeting the requirements of the Truth in Taxation Law.
