POLICIES & SERVICES AT A GLANCE



SCAN ME

To establish safe and thriving communities, residents are responsible for reviewing the policies, services, and resources in their entirety in the **Living on Campus Handbook**.

Point your phone's camera at the code to view the handbook.

SERVICE DESK & ON-CALL STAFF: Each community has a service desk, but it may be housed in a building other than your own. Service desks are staffed from 7:00 a.m. – 1:00 a.m. Phone numbers for on-call staff are posted at the service desk should you need assistance outside of those hours. Submit facility work orders 24/7 in your housing portal. If you are experiencing a facility emergency, contact in-hall staff. In case of emergencies, contact LSU Police at 225-578-3231 or 911.

GUESTS & VISITATION: A guest is defined as any individual who is not an authorized resident of the specific residence hall, apartment, or room in question. Each guest must have a resident host and be escorted at all times within the Residential Life community. Residents are responsible for notifying guests of university and Residential Life policies and procedures and will be held accountable for the behavior of their guests.

Guest Visitation Hours

When classes are in session: Sunday - Thursday: 10:00 a.m. - 1:00 a.m.
Friday - Saturday: 10:00 a.m. - 3:00 a.m.

When classes are not in session: 10:00 a.m. – 3:00 a.m.

FIRE SAFETY: Candles, air fryers, space heaters, appliances with open heating elements, and other flammable items are not permitted in residence halls. When an alarm is activated or when instructed by LSU or emergency personnel, residents and guests are required to evacuate a building. View fire evacuation routes on page 27 in the Living On Campus Handbook.

ALCOHOL: Consumption and/or possession of alcoholic beverages are not permitted by anyone in/on balconies, stairways, hallways, courtyards, parking lots, laundry rooms, or any public area within Residential Life communities. View the complete alcohol policy on page 21 in the Living On Campus Handbook.

DRUGS: Illegal use, possession, distribution, or manufacture of drugs or controlled substances is not permitted within or near Residential Life buildings. Possession or use of drug related paraphernalia is also prohibited.

TOBACCO: The use of tobacco, tobacco products, vaporizers/vapes, and electronic cigarettes is prohibited on campus and within Residential Life communities. Residents will be assessed a fee to their university account in incidents where the room, apartment, or building alarm system is activated due to the use of these products.

CIVIL RIGHTS & TITLE IX: The Office of Civil Rights & Title IX oversees the university's compliance with The Americans with Disabilities Act, Civil Rights, The Joanne Clery Act, and Title IX enforcement and procedures. More information may be found at lsu.edu/engagement/ocr-tix

SEXUAL MISCONDUCT: LSU Permanent Memorandum 73 (PM 73) outlines the procedures for addressing and resolving allegations of Sexual Misconduct (e.g. sexual assault, stalking, dating violence, domestic violence, sexual exploitation, sexual harassment, retaliation, etc.). GETTING CONNECTED

SET UP CABLE TV

One cable TV port is active in each campus res hall room or apartment living room. If you plug your TV in and it doesn't work, try the other cable port in the room.

You may need to perform a digital channel scan. This setting can be found in your TV's Settings menu.

WIRED INTERNET

Each room has one active internet port to use with a LAN cable. Wired internet is the fastest and most reliable option available on campus.

Gaming consoles must be connected via LAN line and registered on the Device Registration Portal (DRP) at <https://drp.lsu.edu> to work on campus.

LSU WIFI

Open the Wi-Fi link on your device.

Click on *eduroam*, then click Connect.

Enter your myLSU ID@lsu.edu address and password to connect.

Each student can register five (5) devices on LSU wired/Wi-Fi networks.

CONNECTING SMART DEVICES TO LSU WIFI

Wireless devices like smart TVs, Rokus, Firesticks, etc., should be registered on the LSU IOT network. The LSU IOT wireless network gives you three (3) registrations to connect smart devices that can't connect to the eduroam wireless network.

However, if your device can connect to eduroam (computers, phones, game consoles via LAN cable), it should be connected to eduroam, not LSUIOT. LSUIOT is not designed to handle the increased traffic from devices like game consoles or computers, so they are prohibited from connecting to LSUIOT. Game consoles should NOT be connected to LSUIOT.

REVIEW YOUR ROOM'S CONDITION

Review your room's condition report in the housing portal **within 72-hours** of checking in to approve or make changes to the room condition report.

Before you arrived, our staff assessed the condition of your room and furniture. This pre-move-in inspection helps us assess any damages or charges when you check out.

After 72 hours, the room condition report is automatically approved.

WORK ORDERS

If you need assistance adjusting the height of your bed or if there are any maintenance or custodial issues that need to be addressed, place a work order request via the housing portal or at your community's service desk.

Please report issues through these official channels so we can address issues as they arise.
