# WHO IS ST. BERNADETTE whose feast day is April 16th?

St. Bernadette of Lourdes was a French nun who lived in the 1800s. She was the first of nine children. Bernadette suffered from illness for most of her life. As a young teenager, she had a series of visions of the Virgin Mary in the Massabielle grotto, ultimately leading to the founding of the shrine of Lourdes.

The beautiful lady asked Bernadette to come here every day for fifteen days. She said that she wanted Bernadette to tell the priests to build a chapel there. Our lady also told Bernadette to pray for the conversion of sinners. Onlookers who didn't see "the Lady" thought Bernadette was mad when she began digging and eating the dirt, which our Lady asked her to do. But shortly afterwards, the hole filled with water, becoming a spring which has since become famous for miraculous cures. Spontaneous healings, many of them miraculous, began during the months of the apparitions to Bernadette. And many healings are still occurring today.

She suffered much of her life from an early age from asthma. Bernadette with severe, chronic asthma, eventually contracted tuberculosis of the lungs. For several months prior to her death, she was unable to take an active part in convent life.

Even on her deathbed Bernadette suffered severe pain and, keeping with the Virgin Mary's admonition of "Penance, Penance," she proclaimed "all this is good for Heaven!" Bernadette's last words were, "Blessed Mary, Mother of God, pray for me."
