

Why Jesus is referred to as a shepherd?

A hired hand tends the sheep for money, while the shepherd does it out of love. Jesus is not merely doing a duty for mankind. He loves us all and has laid down His very life for each of us.

In Jesus' description of Himself in John 10 he adds to our understanding of what makes for a good shepherd. The good shepherd is sacrificial. He is willing to ignore his own needs in order to meet the needs of the sheep. Over and over in the passage he states the good shepherd gives his own life for his sheep.

Throughout the Bible, shepherds are used to represent leaders of God's people (see Isaiah 63:11; Jeremiah 23:2). Shepherds watch for enemies who might attack the sheep, and they defend them when necessary. They tend to sick or wounded sheep and search for lost ones.

Priests have taken on the role as shepherds. We, as the sheep, look to our shepherds for growth in our faith and guidance to life everlasting with our loving God. Pray for our 'shepherds' EVERY DAY. The devil knows their roles and the importance they have in our salvation.

Catholics belong to a Christ-centered faith community that views Jesus Christ as the foundation. Catholics share Jesus' vision and are expected to model their lives after Jesus' example of love. Catholics are called to care for one another and to use their unique gifts and talents for the good of the community and the world.
