Who is St. Faustina?

St. Faustina Kowalska recorded divine encounters in her Diary, which she kept at the specific request of the Lord Jesus and her confessors. In it, she recorded faithfully all of the Lord Jesus' wishes and also described the encounters between her soul and Him. "You are the secretary of My most profound mystery." the Lord said to St. Faustina. Jesus was referring to the great Mystery of Mercy.

Jesus, in a 1931 vision to Faustina, said "Paint an image according to the pattern you see, with the inscription: Jesus, I trust in You." In a subsequent vision, Jesus said, "The pale ray stands for the Water which makes souls righteous; the red ray stands for the Blood which is the life of souls.

"All grace flows from mercy, and the last hour abounds with mercy for us. Let no one doubt concerning the goodness of God; even if a person's sins were as dark as night, God's mercy is stronger than our misery. "St. Faustina said.
