May I never boast except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, through which the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world. Gal. 6:14

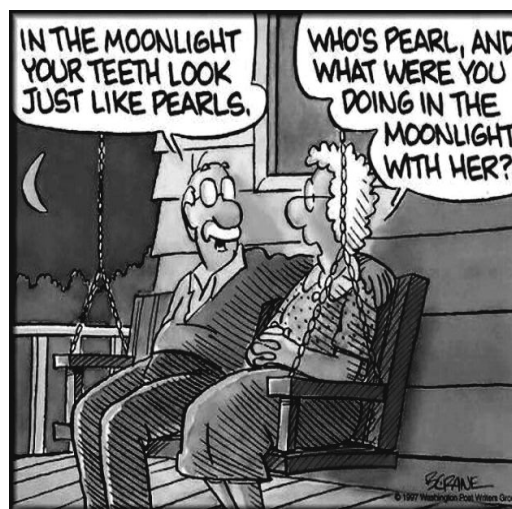


Seminarians For the next several weeks, we will pray specific prayers for our Seminarians as they embark upon a beautiful, challenging, and deeply spiritual journey.

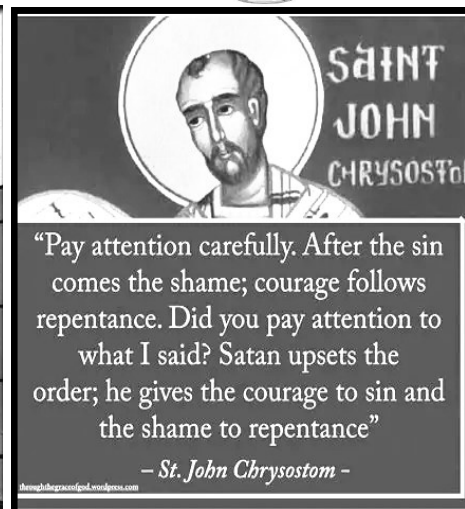
Prayer for Wisdom in Learning
