




- Daily Mass every Thursday at 9:30am (Rosary @ 9:10)

The Feast of the Baptism of the Lord

or Theophany, is the feast day commemorating the baptism of Jesus in the Jordan River by John the Baptist. Originally the baptism of Christ was celebrated on the Epiphany, which commemorates the coming of the Magi.

The baptism of Jesus by John the Baptist is described in all four Gospels (Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John), though the Gospel of John presents it differently, focusing on John the Baptist's testimony rather than a direct narrative of the event, while Matthew, Mark, and Luke provide parallel accounts highlighting the Holy Spirit's descent and a voice from heaven, marking the start of Jesus' public ministry.

In Christian theology, especially Catholic tradition, baptism incorporates believers into Christ, sharing His threefold office as **Priest**, **Prophet**, and **King**, calling them to sanctify the world, witness to God's truth, and serve with humble leadership over themselves and creation. As **priests**, they offer spiritual sacrifices and intercede; as **prophets**, they proclaim faith through words and actions; and as **kings**, they exercise self-mastery and guide others toward God's kingdom, reflecting Christ's own roles.


