Dear Fellow FCCC Member,

The Board of Directors of Franklin County Country Club is pleased to offer members the opportunity to participate directly in an important capital improvement initiative; the replacement and modernization of our golf course irrigation system. This project represents a critical investment in the long-term quality, playability, and sustainability of our course. Prior to securing external financing, the Board believes it is appropriate to offer members the opportunity to participate in funding a portion of this project through a structured member loan program.

Investment Opportunity Overview:

- Total Offering Amount: \$1,500,000
- Minimum Investment: \$250,000
- Interest Rate: 5.00% fixed
- Term: 54 months
- Security: Cash flow of CIF program
- Payments: Quarterly interest payments for six months, followed by quarterly principal and interest payments

Why this opportunity may be attractive. This program is designed to create a mutual benefit for both the Club and participating members. Members can earn a competitive fixed return that currently exceeds comparable CD rates (~4.35%), while supporting an investment that enhances the overall Club experience. At the same time, the Club benefits from reducing borrowing costs and maintaining financial flexibility.

- Indication of Interest Deadline: July 15
- Funding Deadline: July 31

If you are interested in participating or would like additional details, please contact the Club office or a member of the Board prior to July 15. Formal loan documentation will be provided to interested participants. Participation is entirely voluntary and will not impact membership status or privileges. Members are encouraged to review the terms carefully and consult with their financial advisor as appropriate.

Capital Update

Down-payments for the upgraded pump station have begun in June. Further down-payments for the irrigation installation are set to begin in July. The Capital Money Market Account balance is \$419,759 at the end of June. The

1st Certificate of Deposit is \$129,953, the 2nd CD is \$92,730, and the 3rd CD is \$149,859. That makes a total of \$792,301 for the Capital Fund balance.

BYLAW AMENDMENT VOTE

Earlier this year, the Board of Directors approved bylaw amendments for Articles X - Election of Board of Directors & XI - Board of Directors. These Board-approved amendments must be ratified by the membership within 12 months or they will cease to be in effect. FCCC will be sending an electronic ballot to eligible members on Monday, July 6th for you to approve or deny the proposed amendments. The Ballot will close at 11:59pm on Monday, July 20th.

1. A redline draft showing the proposed changes to the existing language
2. A modernized rewrite of the bylaw language incorporating all Board-approved changes
