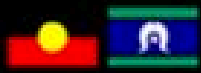

# Why is voting important to you?

Voting is important for many different reasons. It could be about putting your views forward; helping your family and community; wanting a seat at the table; or having a say about who represents you in Parliament. It is compulsory by law for all eligible Australian citizens to enrol and vote. If you are 16 or 17 you can enrol now so when you turn 18 you'll be able to vote.
