The registration, granted by the Victorian Housing Registrar, is a formal recognition that MVAC meets the rigorous performance standards required for governance, financial management, and service delivery in the community housing sector. This new status is the culmination of years of strategic planning and dedicated work by the MVAC team and Board. As a Registered Housing Provider, MVAC is now eligible to access specific state and federal government funding streams, partner on major housing projects, and directly manage social and affordable housing properties. This capability represents a monumental step forward in the organisation's ability to provide holistic, wrap-around support for the community.



APRAP FORUM



The Fifth APRAP Forum was held on August 14th in Bendigo. Gazi and Jessie Marson attended the forum and it highlighted a 2024 Snapshot Update about renting in Victoria from the Commissioner for Residential Tenancies, Dr Heather Holst. The Introduction of Rental Dispute Resolution Victoria (RDRV) which is a Victorian Government initiative that provides information and assistance to renters and rental providers, helping them to resolve disputes fairly and efficiently, was an exciting update for the sector.
