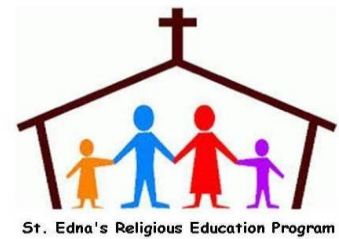

- ❖ To be considered finished for each chapter, the quiz must be completed and submitted to the email address listed. I will work with the teachers to check in each of these items from your child each week.
- ❖ The chapters are to be completed as a family. Please take the time to work with your child each week. I will make sure to be available to each of you for support and offer as many resources as possible I can for you.
- ❖ Textbook pick up will take place during the Family Event in September or a pre-scheduled date in the parish office.

- ❖ We will continue to connect with the students on site for Review Sessions once a month in both the Doherty and Hurley Centers.
- ❖ Attendance at the FAMILY EVENTS is part of both the Religious Education and Confirmation programs. This is our onsite parish family get-togethers to take time to get to know each other, pray, learn, and serve our fellow brothers and sisters in our community. Whole families are invited to attend these sessions along with the students in the program. We will begin in prayer, connect socially, and then participate in a family service project. There are two session options for your family to attend. (Sunday or Tuesday) Please choose the session that fits your family schedule best. If you need to change between the two over the year that is perfectly fine, you are not committed to the same day each month.
- ❖ We will conclude our year with an End of the Year mass and family celebration. This will complete your child's school year. (Date for the Mass is listed above)
- ❖ In the calendar you will also notice dates in **Purple** that highlight those special days for the students preparing for the sacraments of Reconciliation and/or Communion. Those families who have students in this preparation program are asked to keep track of those special dates and participate in these events as well. Failure to attend the actual session or don't make it up, will result in holding back the sacrament until the following year.
