WHEREAS, the tax revenues in the aforementioned budget are necessary and appropriate for funding the 2025-2026 District budget, and

WHEREAS, all other requirements under law have been met,

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Jackson County Emergency Services District No. 3

That the 2025 tax rate per \$100 valuation for property within Jackson County Emergency Services District No. 3 shall be set as follows:

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Debt	0.0109
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Total	0.1000






