Gruber Röschitz Grüner Veltliner

Location: Weinviertel, Austria

Grape: Grüner Veltliner

Aromas: Green apple, grapefruit, white pepper, fresh herbs

Palate: Crisp and refreshing, with citrus, minerality and a distinctive peppery finish

Pairing: Oysters, schnitzel, Thai cuisine

Austrian original: Grüner Veltliner is Austria's most widely planted grape and is famous for its distinctive white-pepper character.



Catena Vista Flores Malbec

Location: Uco Valley, Argentina

Grape: Malbec

Aromas: Blackberry, plum, black cherry, violet, vanilla

Palate: Rich and concentrated, with dark fruit, ripe tannins and refreshing acidity

Pairing: Beef empanadas, lamb, BBQ pulled pork, Burgers

High-altitude pioneer: The Catena family helped put Argentine Malbec on the world stage by planting vineyards at elevations over 1,100 metres.



Dirty Laundry Hush Rose

Location: Okanagan Valley, Summerland, BC

Grapes: Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Pinot Noir, Cabernet Sauvignon

Aromas: Strawberry, raspberry, pink grapefruit, floral notes

Palate: Bright and refreshing, with tart red fruit, crisp acidity and a clean finish

Pairing: Sushi, grilled chicken

The name says it all: An upstairs room in an 1800s laundry shop in Summerland became a gathering place for railroad workers, earning the nickname "Dirty Laundry."



Château Argadens Rouge Bordeaux

Location: Bordeaux, France

Grapes: 65% Merlot, 28% Cabernet Sauvignon, 7% Petit Verdot

Aromas: Blackberry, blackcurrant, cherry, violet, cedar, leather

Palate: Full-bodied and structured, with ripe dark fruit, fine tannins, subtle oak and a lingering finish

Pairing: Steak, duck, aged cheese

Centuries of history: The estate has historic buildings dating back to the 12th and 16th centuries. Maison Sichel purchased the property in 2002 and produced its first vintage that same year.
