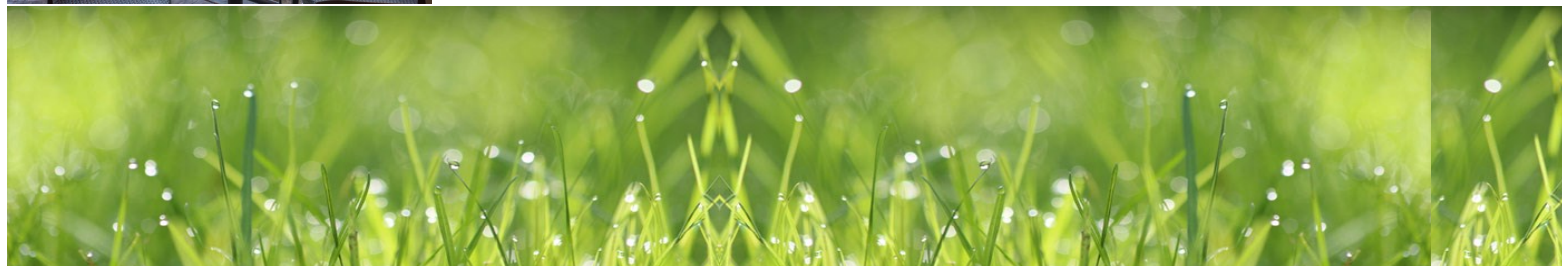

Notes From the Head Golf Professional

Summer has arrived, schools are out and our sleepy little town of Arnold has doubled in size. Because of this, we now have many new club members who are still trying to get a feel for how things work at our facility.

With that said, I would like to present a few suggestions on how we can work together to provide a fun and enjoyable experience for our members and guests...

1. Plan ahead!

Golf members may book tee times two weeks in advance.

Social members may book tee times one week in advance (limited to four rounds per year.)

If you decide you want to play at the last minute, please call ahead to check on course availability.

Walk-ons are allowed, however, if showing up to play unannounced you may have to wait longer than expected or may not be able to play at all. We will always do our best to accommodate all members whenever possible.

2. Keep up to date by visiting sequoiawoods.com.

Our website is where you can access our month-to-month calendar that lists all club events for the year, men's and women's league play days and times, Golf Shop hours of operation and more.

The "Fore! Cast" newsletter is posted in the Membership section of the website, and features informative articles with tournament results, club updates, events, activities and more.

can be found in the Golf section. Members can access each upcoming golf event or Junior Golf Clinic for details and registration.

3. Book your tee times according to your skill level and pace of play. The golf shop staff will always be available to help guide you and suggest appropriate times.

4. Please observe and follow our club dress codes and policies, which include:

Men and boys must wear shirts with collars.

Women may wear shirts without collars.

Tank tops must be at least 2" on the shoulder (*no spaghetti straps*).

Halter tops or short shorts are not allowed.

Blue jeans or cut-offs are not allowed.

Complete policies pertaining to golf and the clubhouse are in our Member Handbook. Just call the Member Services office if you need a new handbook: 209-795-1000 ext. 8.

Our golf course superintendent, Paul Watts, and his crew have done an outstanding job in preparing our course for the upcoming season. As members, it is our responsibility to help keep our course in its great condition by remembering to always replace divots and repair ball marks on the greens. If we all make a point to remind each other, as well as ourselves, to do these simple tasks, our facility will continue to be the best that it has come to be!

The golf shop staff is dedicated to accommodating your needs as best we can and will do our best to suggest and provide times that work for you and your guests. Once again... a friendly reminder to, **Plan Ahead!**

GOLF HOURS FOR JULY:

- ◇ If weather allows, July hours will be:
7am to 5pm Sunday through Thursday
7am to 6pm Friday & Saturday
(play is not permitted before 7am)
- ◇ Golf carts are required to be returned to the golf shop **no later than 8pm** for the month of July.
- ◇ Last golf cart rental is 15 minutes before closing time
- ◇ Please check in 15 minutes prior to your scheduled tee time.
- ◇ Driving Range open: Friday-Sunday 7am to 6pm

Notes From the General Manager, Bob Russell

SOME REMINDERS:

Billing Portal If you need help accessing the online portal, please reach out to our **Member Services office** (see page 4 of this newsletter...)

Dogs Dog owners must help us by cleaning up after their animals **EVEN ON THE GOLF COURSE**. In a final effort to let dogs remain on our property, we have purchased a "Dog Waste Station" that includes bags and a waste basket to dispose of the bags. It will be located at the bottom of the stairs leading from the deck to the pro shop area. If everyone helps us, then we will continue to let leashed dogs on our property. If our customers don't take responsibility, this privilege will end.

Private carts All golf carts that are driven on Sequoia Woods property must display a current "SWCC 2026 Trail Fee" sticker. You can notify us of your intent to use your cart either at the pro shop or at my office. You'll be billed the appropriate trail fee cost, and you will also need to provide us with a copy of your insurance policy that covers use of your cart. After discussions with various members we realize that some private cart owners have avoided notifying the club or paying the cart fee; this is against our policy and is unfair to the members who do the right thing.

GOLF

Pace of Play

- ◆ Always keep pace with the group in front. If your group is keeping up, then no one can say you're playing too slow or holding them up.
- ◆ Play from the appropriate tees based on skill level. With young children, have them tee off from a distance from which they can reach the green within four shots. (Junior tees can be from the 200, 150 and 100 yard markers in the fairways)
- ◆ If you are intimidated from a forced carry or tee shot over water, it's ok to drop a ball and tee it up from the other side.
- ◆ Play ready golf. Don't stand around and watch each other. Be ready and focused for your next shot.
- ◆ If you're having a bad hole and have reached a large number of shots before getting to the green, pick up and move to the next hole. You will avoid frustration and have time to regroup for the next hole.
- ◆ Plan on making tee times based on your group's skill level. Beginners, families with young children and groups or couples that enjoy a slower and less pressured pace are encouraged to make inquiries with the golf shop staff as to the best times to play.

Golf Carts

- ◆ All members and guests must have a valid driver's license in order to operate a golf cart on SWCC property, including private and leased carts
- ◆ Fees are required for all motorized golf carts when used on SWCC property.
- ◆ Seasonal SWCC golf cart leases are available.
- ◆ All private cart owners must pay a yearly trail fee.
- ◆ SWCC cart rental rates are per person: \$12 for nine holes; \$22 for 18 holes.
- ◆ A member riding in another member's private cart must pay the appropriate cart fee.
- ◆ A member's guest does not have to pay to ride in the member's private cart.

Golf Carts, continued.

- ◆ Avoid driving straight down the middle of fairways by entering and exiting at 45 to 90 degree angles.
- ◆ Carts are required to stay on the path on our back 9 unless authorized by the golf shop staff. A blue handicap flag is required for authorization.
- ◆ All golfers, including those with blue flag privileges, must keep golf carts at least 10 yards from all tees and greens, no exceptions.

Tee Times

- ◆ Members may make tee times two (2) weeks in advance.
- ◆ Please make it a point to cancel a tee time 24 hrs. in advance. As a courtesy to others, if a time cannot be utilized please let us know the day before. If a member continues to ignore this policy, once warned, they may lose their two-week privilege.
- ◆ Tee time reservations are on a first-call basis. Monthly standing times will not be allowed.
- ◆ Only the members themselves may make a tee time for a guest or relative. A member may call the shop in advance to "ok" a call from a friend or relative that will be playing as a guest of theirs.
- ◆ Season-long midweek time blocks will only be held for the Men's and Women's Clubs.
- ◆ Member/Guest outings occurring Fridays, Saturdays, Sundays and holidays will be limited to 24 players. Advance reservations are required.
- ◆ When making times for one (1), two (2), or three (3) players, be prepared to have other players assigned to your group.
- ◆ Single, walk-on players are welcome but may have to wait until a spot becomes available.
- ◆ Five (5) players in a group are only allowed Monday through Friday, or at the discretion of the pro shop staff. If a five-some can't keep up with the pace of play, they'll be asked to split up.
- ◆ Junior golfers may play without adult supervision only with the approval of the golf shop staff.
- ◆ Always make a point to call ahead when coming to the course without a scheduled tee time.

- ♦ All golf memberships include eight (8) half-price guest fees that may be utilized throughout the season.
- ♦ Half-price guest fees are good any time Monday through Friday and after 12:00 noon on weekends or holidays.
- ♦ Shop staff will only apply these discounts when asked by the member at time of check in.
- ♦ These discounts are for accompanied guests only, unless the member cannot be present and has given his permission to utilize the discount in advance.
- ♦ Discounts do not carry over from year to year.
- ♦ Please specify nine or eighteen holes when checking in
- ♦ Junior rates for guests are only available Monday through Friday.
- ♦ If a guest is old enough to drive a cart, then he or she is not considered a junior.

Booking Tee Times at SWCC:

Full Golf Members:

- ◆ Parties of up to eight (8) players: can book any day and time, two weeks in advance
- ◆ Groups of 12 to 24 players: mid-week, any time.
- ◆ Groups of 12 to 24 players: weekends or holidays after 11:00am only, unless authorized by the head professional or first assistant.
- ◆ Large groups or outings scheduled in advance of two weeks must be made through the head professional or first assistant.
- ◆ Golf members may call and book times for up to four (4) un-accompanied guests, two weeks in advance, weekdays any time, weekends after 11:00am

Partial/Weekday Golf Members:

- ◆ Parties of up to eight (8) players: Monday through Friday, any time, with two weeks advance booking
- ◆ May play on Sundays after 12:00 noon, if available, with one week advance booking only
- ◆ Saturdays, Holidays and Sundays of a three-day weekend are not allowed.
- ◆ May book up to four (4) players on a weekend, one week advance booking, and pay regular fees.
- ◆ Golf member may call and book times for up to four (4) un-accompanied guests, one week in advance Monday through Friday only. No weekends or holidays.
- ◆ Groups of 12 to 24 players: Monday through Friday, after 10:00am, unless authorized by the head professional or first assistant.

Social Members:

- ◆ Must pay regular guest fees; limited to four (4) foursomes, per year
- ◆ May book a tee time one week in advance.
- ◆ Any time Monday through Friday and after 11:00am on weekends or holidays.
- ◆ Cannot book tee times for un-accompanied guests.
