Dr Jade Wilkinson is a HCPC-registered Clinical Psychologist who has worked with individuals across the lifespan in the NHS for almost 10 years. Since qualifying as a Clinical Psychologist, Jade has worked within multi-disciplinary teams in the fields of neuropsychology and spinal injuries. She supports patients with brain injuries, neurological disorders and spinal injuries, offering assessment, formulation and interventions to support their psychological needs. She also conducts cognitive assessments to inform a holistic formulation and support with rehabilitation planning.

Jade takes an integrative approach to psychological therapy, considering intervention options based on person-centred formulations, including the use of Acceptance and Commitment Therapy (ACT), Cognitive-Behavioural Therapy (CBT), Compassion-Focussed Therapy (CFT) and Solution-Focussed Therapy. She has worked with people from minoritised groups and believes in taking a whole-system approach to formulation to understand the systems around the individual and their impact.

Jade has been involved in research for almost 10 years, supporting psychological research at the University of Leeds and University of Oxford, leading research on LGBTQ+ affirmative therapy and exploring the evaluation of mood within specialist neurorehabilitation.
