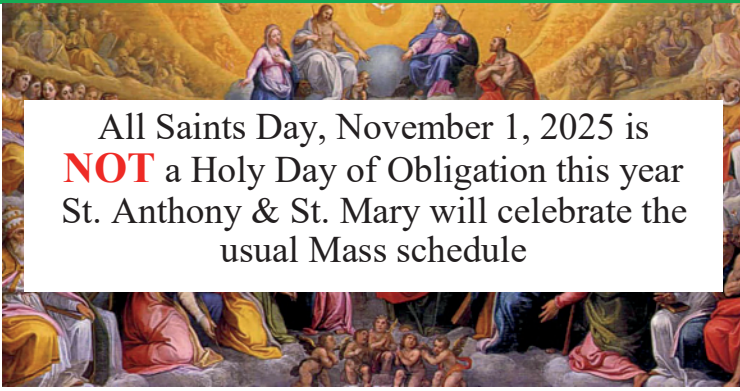

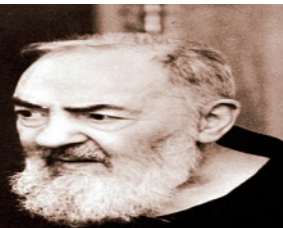

- Befriend priests & religious. Invite a priest, sister, or brother to dinner at your home. Personal relationships are key.

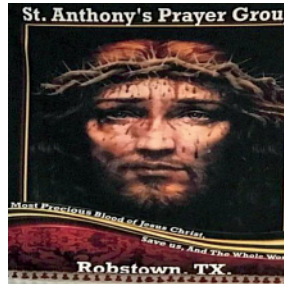
If you're apprehensive, trust in God's plan. The best thing you can say is, "Whatever God wants for you, I want for you, too."

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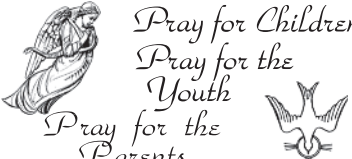
