

Expectations:

- Mobile phones to stay at home, or placed out of the way to not cause a distraction to others.
- That you engage and aim to complete tasks / work provided at Regency Source Alternative Provision.
- Arrival between 9:30 and 10am.
- No form of physical, emotional, sexual (including child on child) or verbal abuse to be used on site towards any member of staff or other students. This includes visitors, outside providers or other staff members associated with Regency Source Alternative Provision.
- Contact will be made with parents / carers with information pertinent to the student but contact will only be between the school day timings plus one hour.
- Swearing is not acceptable at all – this includes directed towards others (staff or students).
- Smoking / Vaping is not permitted but we recognise that some students and staff do so we ask that this is done during break times and away from school site.
- That you are here, take part and work with us so that we can allow you to achieve success.
- That you take pride in the things you do and recognise your own sense of self worth.
- To realise that you are wanted here, that you are well liked and that we want the best for you!

Values

Our values underpin everything that we do. From the moment we meet you, we want you to feel part of what we do here at Regency Source Alternative Provision.

Respect - We will always treat you with respect, kindness and care. We expect the very best from you and will always support you to become the best version of yourself.

Routine - We will always provide a clear structure of how to succeed, learn, enjoy and grow as you spend time with us. We are a safe and caring place for you to flourish.

Recognise - We will help you recognise your own potential, your own self-worth, your strengths, your areas to develop but above all to recognise that you are wanted here.

Real - We will always be honest and open with you, we expect the same in return. We will always be the same on your good days and your bad as they all form part of your learning journey with us.

Our expectations of your behaviour are non-negotiable. Any of these which are not adhered to can result in the following action:

- 1) If they (expectations) are not adhered to, a time of 1 or 2 days reflection / exclusion will be given. The number of days will be decided by the Head of AP, Managing Director of Regency Source and the Teaching Team.
- 2) If, after the reflection / exclusion any of the expectations are not adhered to again, the placement will be permanently cancelled.
