

Notifying the Public of Rights under Title VI

Tri-County Community Action Agency operates its programs and services without regard to race, color, or national origin, in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.

If you believe you have been discriminated against on the basis of race, color, or national origin by Tri-County Community Action Agency you may file a Title VI complaint by completing, signing, and submitting the agency's Title VI Complaint Form.

How to file a Title VI complaint with Tri-County Community Action Agency

1. A Complaint Form may be obtained from the Tri-County Community Action Agency website: www.tccaaky.org, or in person from the Tri-County Community Action Agency office at

2. Complaints must be filed within 180 days following the date of the alleged discriminatory occurrence and should contain as much detailed information about the alleged discrimination as possible.
