

## **RENT READY CHECKLIST**

Here is a general checklist of what we look for to make sure your property is considered **Move-In Ready**.

- Professional-quality Janitorial (there should be no crumbs, streaks, dirt, dust, grime, etc. on any surface; home should be fully cleaned)
- Professional Carpet Shampoo/cleaning
- Landscaping to be cleaned up & trimmed (free of weeds, debris, pet waste, etc.)
- Keys & remotes to be provided for any lock or amenity (There should not be keyed locks on interior bedroom doors)
- All light fixtures to have proper, matching & working bulbs installed
- Garage & driveway to be cleaned of any grease or other grime
- All sink & tub drains to have operational stoppers installed
- All drains in the home to drain properly (no clogs or backups) & garbage disposal to work properly
- All showers without doors to have a shower rod installed (no curtain)
- Ceilings fans & other fixtures to be in working condition
- Any old/marked up toilet seats to be replaced
- No leaks of any kind (including, but not limited to: faucets, shower heads, plumbing valves)
- Fresh full paint or proper paint touch-up & any drywall holes to be patched & painted (walls & doors to be free of marks/holes. Paint touch up should look seamless & with the proper sheen)
- Working & up-to-date smoke detectors
- All outlets & switches to have cover plates installed
- Window coverings to be in good condition
- New A/C Filters installed in the A/C vents
- Any caulking that is old/worn should be addressed (countertops/showers/bathtubs, etc.)
- No broken glass (mirrors/windows, etc.)
- No cameras of any type should be left <u>installed</u> on the property for privacy reasons (Ring doorbell camera is an exception)
- If you have a pool, there must be a safety feature included (such as door alarms or locked pool fence)

Overall the homeowner should ensure all appliances /electrical /plumbing items are in good working order to the best of their knowledge (including but not limited to: HVAC System, Kitchen Appliances, Washer/Dryer, Water Heater) McKenna Property Management does NOT conduct inspections on any appliances of the home, we only conduct a visual evaluation prior to putting the home on the market to confirm it is cosmetically move-in ready.
