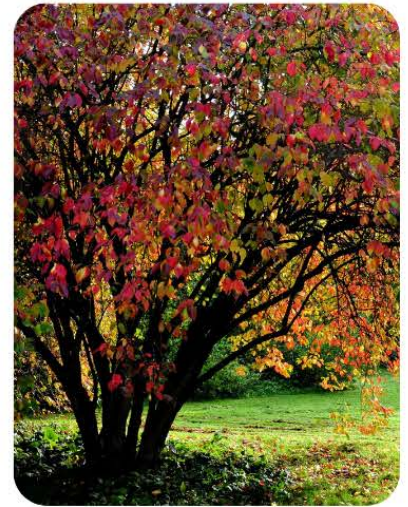




Learn More About Nannyberry!

Scientific Name: *Viburnum lentago*

MATURE SIZE: Height 14–18 ft Width 10–15 ft

A Chicago-area native that works in almost any yard condition — full sun, full shade, wet soil, or dry. In late spring it produces clusters of small creamy-white flowers followed by berries that ripen from yellow to deep blue-black, attracting over 35 bird species. Fall foliage turns a rich burgundy-red. Naturally upright and graceful, it requires little to no pruning.
