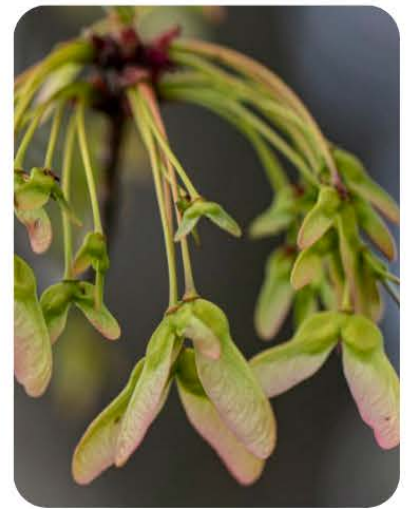




Learn More About Red Maple!

Scientific Name: *Acer rubrum*

MATURE SIZE: Height 40–60 ft Width 35–45 ft

Red maple is a widely adaptable, large tree common to the woods of eastern North America. A red tinge can be found in its flowers, twigs, and seeds, but it is most notable for the scarlet of its leaves in fall. Red maple needs plenty of room for its dense, spreading root system. Maples are considered ‘bleeders’ and are best pruned in early winter or during summer.



HIGHLIGHTS

- Flood supportive tree that soaks up rainwater and enjoys wet/moist soils.
- Spectacular reddish color in fall and red buds in spring.
- One of the most ecologically successful trees in the midwest and eastern United States.
