



Learn More About Serviceberry!

Scientific Name: *Amelanchier spp.*

MATURE SIZE: Height 15–25 ft Width 15–20 ft

Serviceberry is often the first tree to bloom in the Chicago area each spring, producing delicate white flowers while most trees are still bare. Sweet, edible blue-purple berries follow in early June and are quickly claimed by birds. Fall color is a reliable orange to red-orange, and the smooth silver-gray bark looks beautiful in winter. A native tree that works well in partial shade.
