Answers to Common Questions about Community Access Partnerships

Why is BECS seeking community sponsorships if camp charges tuition?

BECS Summer Camp is designed to be financially sustainable through tuition. However, the cost of providing this camp experience may be beyond the financial reach of some families. Your partnership can help reduce financial barriers by providing tuition assistance for eligible families.

How are Community Access Sponsorships used?

Community Access Sponsorships are applied directly to tuition assistance for eligible families, helping reduce financial barriers to participation.

Is my sponsorship tax-deductible?

BECS is a for-profit educational consulting company. Community Access Sponsorships are not represented as tax-deductible charitable contributions. Sponsors are encouraged to consult their tax professional regarding potential business expense treatment.

How are scholarship recipients selected?

Families complete a scholarship application, and assistance is awarded based on eligibility and available sponsorship funding.

Can I support more than one child?

Absolutely. Businesses may sponsor multiple camp days, multiple weeks, or contribute at any partnership level.

How many children will attend camp?

BECS Summer Camp is intentionally small, with a maximum of 10 children per week. This allows us to maintain high staff ratios and deliver the individualized support our campers need. In our 2026 pilot year, we expect to serve a total of 25–35 children across the season, with 10–12 of those spots supported through community partnerships.

How will my business be recognized?

Recognition is based on the selected partnership level and may include website acknowledgment, social media recognition, sponsor materials, and other opportunities outlined in this packet.

Will BECS Summer Camp continue to grow?

The 2026 camp season represents the launch of BECS Summer Camp and an opportunity to better understand community need.

As the program grows, BECS will continue exploring ways to expand community partnerships and increase scholarship opportunities so more families can access specialized summer programming.
