Golf Course Update: March 2026

With Spring right around the corner and the warm weather approaching it looks like winter just might be behind us! With the nicer weather, and the itch to get outdoors and play golf again, we wanted to provide an update.

This has been a long winter for us on Cape Cod; we have experienced the most snowfall since 2015. This winter was not an easy one for the courses, and it went out with a bang! The latest storm brought close to two feet of snow and 70mph winds. The courses sustained considerable damage with 50+ trees down and significant amounts of debris throughout. Due to the snowpack, we were unable to get out onto the courses.

With 50- and 60-degree temperatures coming in, we know that you will be eager to play golf. We too are eager to see you, but we will need a few weeks to get the courses into playable condition. The Yarmouth Golf team is ready to begin the clean-up, and we should be able to begin late next week.

We have dedicated all resources to get Bass River Golf Course open as soon as we can. There will be numerous teams helping with the clean-up efforts, with an all-hands-on deck approach. Bayberry Hills Golf Course will be delayed in opening this season, once completed at Bass River we will allocate our resources to Bayberry Hills.

This offseason was different than most, but we do have some good news to share. We have completed a revamp of the Grille area at Bass River, along with a renovation of the proshop area. For Bayberry, a new fence was installed for the cart staging area, and minor changes to proshop layout.

Our big offseason project is set to begin in late March with the renovation of the patio at Bayberry Hills Clubhouse. We are excited for this new addition with anticipated completion date of May 1st.

We appreciate your patience and understanding as we get the golf courses back online for the 2026 season. We will continue to share updates as the clean-up efforts progress. We are looking forward to seeing the clubs swinging again.
