NOVEMBER VEHICLE OF THE MONTH



ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING – 30 November 2025



The Annual General meeting was held in November with a huge attendance of nearly 100 people. The committee remains the same except for one new member who came forward to replace Phil Johnson who had regrettably decided not to stand again. Phil was thanked for his time on the committee and presented with a Marks and Spencer Gift card and Wine.

I thanked Tim Pallot for compiling the 2026 calendar which was distributed at the close of the meeting. I hope you have all received your copy and found your remittance advice inside the envelope for the Annual subscription. A reminder that you must use your new Club Account number when paying your subscription by Bank Transfer or write it on the back of your cheque if paying by cheque.

The new 2026 committee was duly elected as follows:

Chairman Frank Laurens, Vice Chairman Pam Laurens, Treasurer Judy Ridley, Secretary Cara Miller, Alan Michel Editor and Membership, John du Heaume and Jim Paton Committee members, Ian Le Brun and Mick Jehan Tractor Section.

I thanked Jim Paton for putting his name forward at the meeting in order that we make a full committee for 2026. A warm welcome to you Jim.

I know that it is difficult to commit oneself to committee and I understand. This Club is a very busy one and one of these days Pam and I would like to stand down. I am hoping that in the next year or two someone may come forward to take over the Chairmanship. I am saying this now so you can all have a think and get prepared.

At the AGM the following was put forward in Any Other Business:

“To consider the inclusion in the Club Constitution the age of a Classic Vehicle”.

Much discussion was put forward by members and it was finally agreed for the Committee to go back and discuss this item and agree wording to be approved at an EGM. It was suggested to hold the EGM at the January monthly meeting.

On January 12th a Government consultation meeting was organised for the Motor Clubs in Jersey which Pam and I attended. It was helpful to all who attended on both sides. We informed them that our Club recognised a classic vehicle to be 20 years and above, however there are the modern classics that can be 15 years old. They realised that perhaps it wasn't age that was significant but the mileage the vehicle did. As we said a classic vehicle is not on the road every day, it does very little mileage compared to a road car etc. Also many classic insurance firms ask you to cap the mileage to 1000, 1500 or 3000 miles a year.

In view of the above the JCVC committee have decided not to change the Constitution for the time being and wait and see what happens in the next 12 months. There will be Government elections in June which may change everything all over again. I hope that you are in favour of this, if not, the committee can meet again and agree on wording, for approval at a future EGM or the next AGM.

Meanwhile we urge you all to complete the phase out survey on the Government website as follows:

It is extremely important that they know all our views.

This survey will end on 30th January 2026.

DECEMBER VEHICLE OF THE MONTH

The Vehicle of the Month for December was a 1970 Mercedes Benz owned by Bruno Bodnar. Congratulations Bruno!

My Mercedes Benz 250 CE Automatic was bought new in 1970 by Mr. Perruchon in St Crois-Valmer near St Tropez, France. It is a W114, classic 2-door coupé featuring a 2.5L inline 6 cylinder petrol engine (M114), producing around 148-150 hp, offering a top speed of roughly 118 mph (190 km/h or more). It was at the time acquired by my brother Laurent in August 2002 in Paris. After several years of use, including my wife's and I wedding (2005), the car was stored for nearly a decade, towards the end of my brother's life, before his passing in early 2023.



In the same year, Mr Manon from Garage du Meridien at Villers-sur-Mer (Normandy) gradually restored it into working order over 18 months, until it passed its road test for a new French log book. It was repatriated to Jersey in early 2025...Finally, Paul from Hefford's Motor Repairs Ltd. helped me pass the DVS inspection for the new Jersey log book. There is still a few issues to fix like the dash clock, centre locking system...That is keeping me busy!



I have enjoyed driving this Mercedes regularly, often accompanied by the songs of Eddy Mitchell, Laurent's favourite singer.

Finally, I would like to thank all the club members for their friendliness and warm welcome. I am very happy to be part of this wonderful community of enthusiasts. I wish that I could come more often to participate in more events.



