Praying for priests and married couples is a great way to show the importance of putting God first in your marriage. This can be taught through crafts like making holy cards for priests or creating a heart out of tissue paper with post-it notes of married couples to pray for. Teaching children about the sacraments can be tricky, but it's essential they understand their significance.
