## GOSPEL MEDITATION

As a priest, I'm amazed how happily married couples remember the tiniest details of their earliest encounters. They effortlessly report things like: "he wore a blue shirt," "we ordered brussels sprouts," "her hair was up in a bun," and "he spilled shrimp cocktail sauce at my family's open front door when it was ten degrees below zero," (that one's courtesy of my mom). We delight in remembering and speaking of when our new life of love began. The little details are glorious reminders that it's all real.

It's similar for John the Apostle. He tells us of the two disciples who followed Jesus into his house, "...they stayed with him that day. It was about four o'clock in the afternoon." Why does that tiny detail matter? Because that's the time of day when they encountered the love of Jesus the Messiah in their lives. Our religion is not primarily about abstract truths about God, no matter how true or sublime. It is about God meeting and saving us in our human nature. It's about a human relationship.

What was the time of day when you first recall encountering Christ and his Church? Who was there? What did you feel? How did things look and smell? What happened? Take some time to recall it in detail. For me, it was inside an old, rickety church on a hillside in Jerome, Arizona. It was about 9 p. m. on a Saturday evening. I was with my friends Jenny, Brad, and Laura. We were praying, singing, and laughing. When was it for you? Remembering the details isn't empty nostalgia. It reminds us now that God's love for us in our humanity is real.

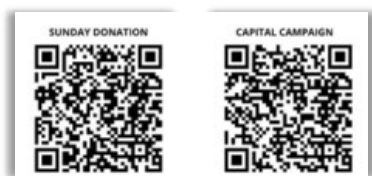

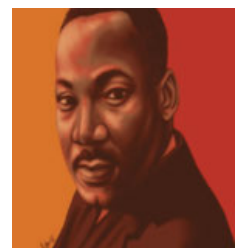

**Jesus & Eucharist Study**

**Jesus and the Eucharist Study**

Every parish across the country is invited to join the Jesus and the Eucharist study during the Year of Parish Revival. This seven-session series will introduce participants to the Eucharist's proclamation (Sections 1-4) and reveal God's loving work in the Eucharist (Sections 5-7).

Each session opens with an introduction from a different bishop, followed by the Eucharist prayer with scripture. The main focus is prayer from scriptures created by the Augustine Institute and will include personal testimonies from Catholics across the country. We will then transition into small group discussions. Each meeting is expected to last around two hours.

BELOW IS AN OVERVIEW OF EACH SESSION:

**Session 1: What's Our Story?**  
The story of the Eucharist has been told in many ways, but it is often told in a way that is not fully understood. This session will explore the Eucharist's history and its meaning in our lives.

**Session 2: Who's Our Jesus?**  
Jesus is both God and man, therefore he reveals who God is in relation to us. Jesus asked Simon Peter, "Who do you say that I am?" (Matthew 16:13) He asks this same question of us as we begin our journey.

**Session 3: How is Jesus?**  
Jesus is a gift from God through Jesus Christ that responds to "yes".

**Session 4: Who is Christ?**  
Jesus didn't merely come as a written message or instruction manual to follow. He gave us a living, breathing Christ where we encounter him personally and allow ourselves to be transformed by his love.

**Session 5: What is the Eucharist?**  
The Eucharist is the sacrament of Christ's presence in the Church. It is the source and summit of the Christian life. This session explores the Eucharist's meaning in our lives and its role in the Church's mission.

**Session 6: The Eucharist and the Church**  
The Eucharist is the sacrament of the Church's unity. It is the source and summit of the Christian life. This session explores the Eucharist's meaning in our lives and its role in the Church's mission.

**Session 7: Bread for the Journey**  
The Eucharist sustains us on our spiritual journey. Our participation in the Eucharist is an offering of thanksgiving to God. We are then sent forth to share what we have received.

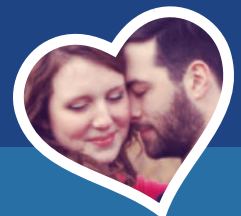

### Sacrament of the Sick / Anointing of the Sick

In the Church's Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick, through the ministry of the priest, it is Jesus who touches the sick to heal them from sin – and sometimes even from physical ailment. His cures were signs of the arrival of the Kingdom of God. The core message of his healing tells us of his plan to conquer sin and death by his dying and rising.

The Rite of Anointing tells us there is **no need to wait until a person is at the point of death** to receive the Sacrament. A careful judgment about the serious nature of the illness is sufficient. When the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick is given, the hoped-for effect is that, if it be God's will, the person be physically healed of illness. But even if there is no physical healing, the primary effect of the Sacrament is a spiritual healing by which the sick person receives the Holy Spirit's gift of peace and courage to deal with the difficulties that accompany serious illness or the frailty of old age.
