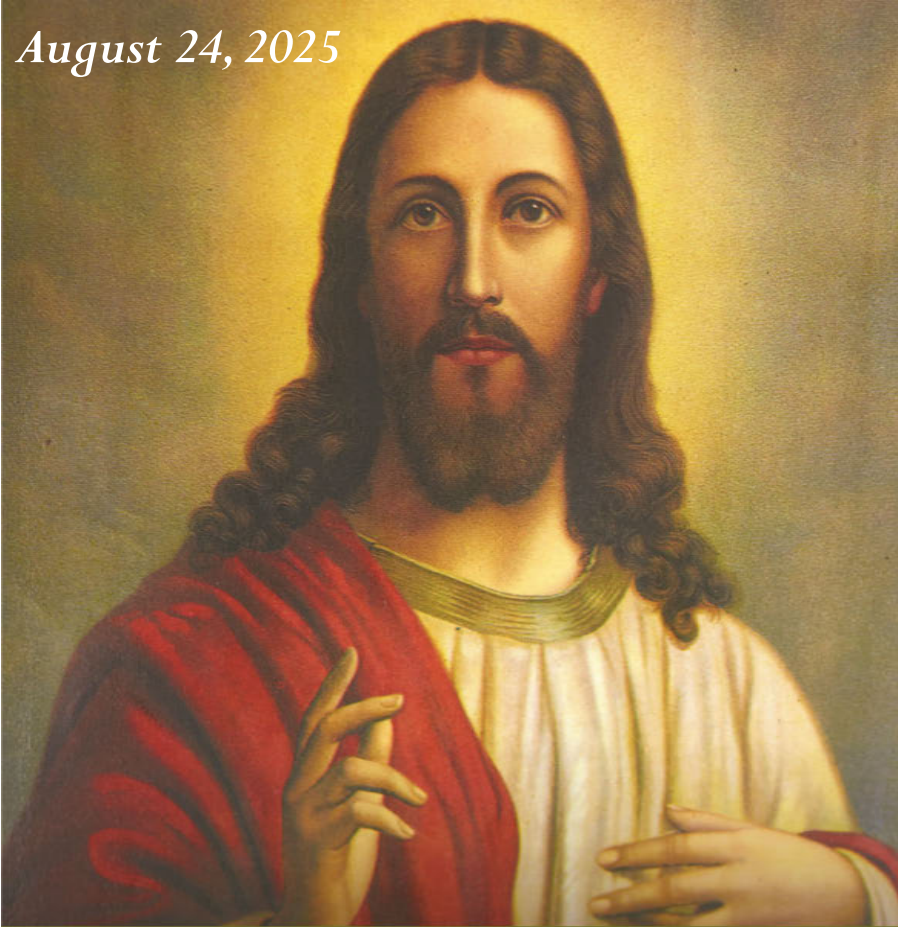

GOSPEL MEDITATION

I've been hiking Camelback Mountain in Phoenix, Arizona most of my life. It is a vigorous forty-five minutes to the top. Near the peak, the end suddenly appears much further away, and steeper. At that moment, a descending hiker often offers encouragement: "Keep going! The peak is right there. It's not as far as it looks. You can do it!" It usually works. After another five minute push, you summit and enjoy a glorious panorama of the Sonoran Desert in the Valley of the Sun.

When Jesus is asked about how many people are saved, he says: "Strive to enter through the narrow gate" (Luke 13:24). How many? Strive! Focus on your journey. What does heavenly census taking have to do with you or me? How would it help a hiker on a mountain to ask the others coming down, "How many people are going to make it to the top?" A normal response would be something like: "How is that a relevant question? Carry on!"

Jesus links one virtue directly to salvation: perseverance (cf. Matt 24:13; hypomone in Greek). Strive! Endure! Keep going! The one absolutely necessary virtue is perseverance, to not give up on our journey. The mountain we struggle to climb is often our own weakness, failures, and sins. Persevere in prayer. Keep celebrating the sacraments. Embrace daily duties. With God's grace, you are strong enough to keep going. Perhaps the peak is not as far away as you might fear. Keep going!

Rooted In Service:

The Growth and Spirit of St. Vincent Ferrer Parish

When St. Vincent first put down roots in the community, ministries seemed to spring up overnight. Parishioners didn't just talk about the Beatitudes—they lived them. The Pro-Life cause was part of the parish's identity from the very beginning. Back in 1967, Father Murray sparked a letter-writing campaign that sent 227 letters to Sacramento, surprising lawmakers who never expected such energy from a retirement community. Caring for the sick and homebound has always been a priority here. Every pastor has poured heart and time into making sure no one is forgotten. In 1991, Fr. Munnely created the Extraordinary Ministry for the homebound, personally delivering the Eucharist every first Friday and rallying parishioners to visit nursing homes and retirement centers. Then came the Rosary Makers in 1992—a handful of parishioners with nimble fingers and big hearts. Their rosaries made their way into prisons, rehab centers, and missions from California to Connecticut. By 1998, this little group had crafted over 10,000 rosaries, spreading hope one bead at a time. The Transportation Ministry hit the road in 1997, giving rides to Mass, doctor's appointments, and even the grocery store. No one was left behind. The first known Ministry Fair was held in October of 2000, called the Harvest Fair. It was designed to provide information and encourage participation from every parishioner. More fairs followed in 2003, 2006, and then annually after 2007. Today, the Ministry Fair is a staple event at St. Vincent, drawing the community together each year. These early ministries set the tone for St. Vincent's future—a place where service is second nature. Today, our ministries reach into every aspect of parish life: community, service, worship, evangelization, and catechesis. And if you've been around a while, you've seen the parish explode in size. What started with about 100 families in 1963 has grown to over 4,000 by 2025. By 2016, it was clear: we needed a bigger church. Fr. Costales, the councils, and the whole community came together to make that vision a reality. Through every change, one thing has stayed constant. St. Vincent Ferrer is a community of believers, called to live the Gospel in ways that ripple out—into our families, our neighborhoods, and beyond—filling lives with faith, hope, and love. That's who we are, and that's where we're headed.

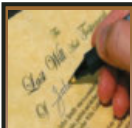

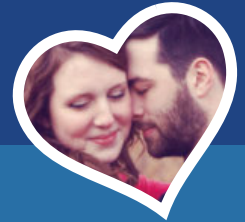
