7. Reconvene into open session to take action as appropriate in the Council's direction regarding appointment, employment, evaluation, duties of employee Cynthia Dosier.
8. Discuss, consider, and act on hiring Cynthia Dosier as City Administrator/Secretary.
9. Discuss, consider, and potentially act upon a proposal from Chris Quinn to write grants for the city.
10. Discuss, consider, and potentially act upon a proposal from Clayton Gaddis as being the attorney for the city.
11. Discuss, consider, and take action on a mobile deposit machine from First State Bank to be able to deposit checks into the bank at the time they are accepted from Colby Reyes, the water and court clerk, with a monthly fee of \$35.00, additional fee for 2 line is \$25.
12. Discuss, consider, and take action pursuant to Section 551.007 on rules for public comment (c) A governmental body may adopt reasonable rules regarding the public's right to address the body under this section, including rules that limit the total amount of time that a member of the public may address the body on a given item.
13. Discuss, consider, and take action on opening a LEOSE account for Police Officer Education funds received from Texas Comptrollers.
14. Discuss, consider, and take action on the purchase of two (2) 2010 Ford Crown Victorias for \$5000 from Mabank ISD Police Dept. for the Trinidad Police Department. Funding for this purchase would utilize the remaining loan balance of the \$8,850 allotted for the two recently purchased Ford Explorers.
15. Discuss, consider, and take action on the official city letter to TXDOT to perform a traffic study to review speed limit through town for possible reduction
16. Discuss, consider, and take action on The Trinidad Event Committee rejoining as a city entity, and adopting the Event Committee bylaws. If approved will terminate the previous contract adopted by the City Council.
17. Discuss, consider, and take action on appointing members to the Event Committee: Dusty Bannister – 1 Year Term, Leah Melton – 1 Year Term, Grace Lawrence – 2 Year Term, and Sarah Mazariegos – 2 Year Term.
18. Discuss, consider and take action on opening two (2) bank accounts, for the event committee: One general account and One Deposit only account. Accounts will

be managed by event committee with the City Administrator, Cynthia Dosier on accounts as an authorized signature along with The President, Dusty Bannister, and Secretary, Sarah Mazariegos, of the Event Committee.

19. **Discuss, consider, and take action for the city to donate the garage sale permit fees to the event committee pending approval by legal,** for the time frame of June 11-13th for the Event Committee to organize a community wide Garage Sale during these days.

20. **Discuss, consider, and take action on the piano at Community Center.** The event committee would like to donate the piano to a long-time resident of Trinidad, Mr. Mizell.
