NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Trinidad, Texas, will hold a Regular Session at the Trinidad City Hall, 100 Park Street, Trinidad, Texas 75163, on the above date and time, for consideration and possible action on the following:

Notice of Possible Quorum: Notice is hereby given that a quorum of the EDC may attend this Council meeting.

1. Call to Order & Establish of Quorum:
2. Invocation
3. Pledge of Allegiance and Texas Pledge
4. VISITORS/ CITIZENS INQUIRY: In accordance with the Open Meetings Act, Council is prohibited from acting or discussing (other than factual responses to specific questions) any items brought before them at this time. This is reserved for items not covered on the agenda. No formal action can be taken on items at this meeting. Discussion is limited to five (5) minutes per person.
5. EXECUTIVE SESSION Pursuant to the Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, The City Council will recess into executive session (closed meeting) to discuss the following: Consultation with Attorney (Tex. Gov't Code §551.071) and Personnel Matters (Tex. Gov't Code§551.074) to deliberate the appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline, or dismissal of a public officer or employee, namely Shellena Bivens.
6. RECONVENE INTO THE SPECIAL SESSION In accordance with Texas Government Code, Chapter 551, the City Council will reconvene into special session to consider action, if any, on matters discussed in executive session.
7. Discuss and possibly take action concerning the dismissal or termination of Shellena Bivens.

8. Discuss and possibly take action to approve a professional services agreement with Flowers Davis PLLC to provide outside legal counsel regarding any and all litigation matters for the City, and authorizing the Mayor Pro Tem to execute the contract.
9. Discuss and possibly take action to terminate the legal services agreement with Clayton B. Gaddis PLLC, and directing the City Administrator Cynthia Dosier to notify the firm and take all necessary steps to protect the City's legal interests.
10. Only if dismissal or termination results from action item number 7., discuss and possibly take action regarding the appointment of Susan Carver as municipal judge.

11. COUNCIL MEMBER INQUIRY TIME Pursuant Tex. Gov. Code Sec 551.042 the mayor or council members may inquire about a subject not specifically listed on this agenda. Responses are limited to a recitation of existing policy or a statement of specific information given in response to the inquiry. Any deliberation or decision shall be limited to a proposal to place the subject on the agenda in the future,
