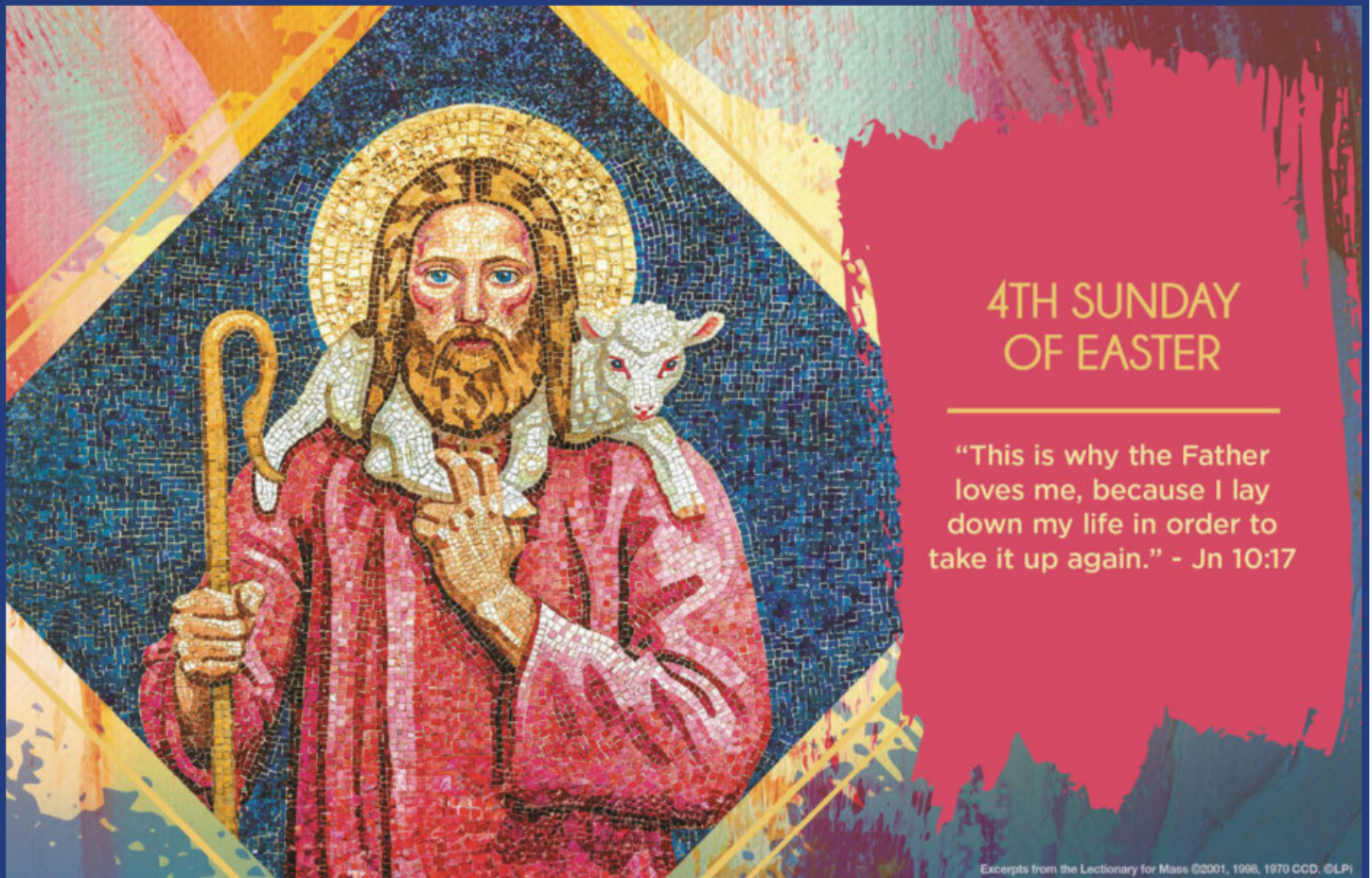

While we are at it, let's congratulate our 8<sup>th</sup> Graders!
