These selections can be added to any of our service package options.

Environmentally friendly selections

Preparation and Care

Embalming - this includes sanitation and temporary preservation of a decedent using only non-toxic, biodegradable chemicals.

Basic Care - for viewings without embalming - this includes sanitation and temporary preservation of a decedent using only non-invasive techniques and materials.

Caskets These products consist only of natural, raw materials; undyed, unbleached, woven cotton, plant-based adhesives, peg & dowel construction, walnut oil & beeswax coatings. Harvested wood is replaced through reforestation with Canadian Conservation Authorities.

Arranging and Co-ordination

The funeral director will require many hours of communication and follow up with Doctors/Coroner, Clergy/Celebrant, Musicians, Crematorium/Cemetery, and other related service providers.

Transfer

Multiple professional staff, PPE and safe handling equipment required, including transfer vehicle for the local transfer of deceased from place of death into the care of the funeral home.

Documentation and Estate Package

The preparation and gathering of all necessary information to complete documents required to permit a cremation or burial (including the time involved in retrieving documents related to the authority of the Coroner and registration of a death within the Province).

An estate package with Funeral Director's Proof of Death Certificates are included as well as application forms related to estate settlement (CPP, Survivors Benefits, cancellation of specific government documents, etc.).

Basic Preparation

Our licensed professional will assess the deceased conditions and restore your loved one's dignity by washing, disinfection, removal of medical implements; dressing and casketing the body.

Embalming

Embalming includes the additional restoration, preservation, cosmetics and hairdressing that allows us to provide you with the best possible experience for viewing your loved one at the funeral home during visitation or private family reflection.

Automobiles

*The lead/administration vehicle is used for administrative errands related to services including registration of death, clergy transportation and funeral processions.

*The Funeral Coach is used to transfer the casket/cremation container or Ceremonial Urn Ark to a church, cemetery or other facility.

*Limousine(s) accommodate up to 7 passengers to transport family, pallbearers or friends to/from the funeral home, church or another facility.

*A Floral vehicle is used for transportation of flowers and equipment to offsite locations for services (ie church, reception hall, cemetery)

Facilities for Visitation and/or Ceremony

Comfortable and private visitation suite/chapel; furnishings, audio visual and related equipment to facilitate your private family reflection and public visitation experience.

Cremated Remains Refundable Deposit

When cremation is selected, the funeral home can request that the purchaser pay a refundable deposit of \$350. The funeral home will retain the cremated remains for an agreed period of time from the date of cremation. If the cremated remains are not claimed within one year, the funeral home may inter the cremated remains in a cemetery, including in a common lot for which the cemetery is the interment rights holder, and the funeral home may retain the deposit referred to in this section. If the cremated remains are claimed before they are interred, the operator will refund any deposit paid as required circumstances permitted by the legislation.

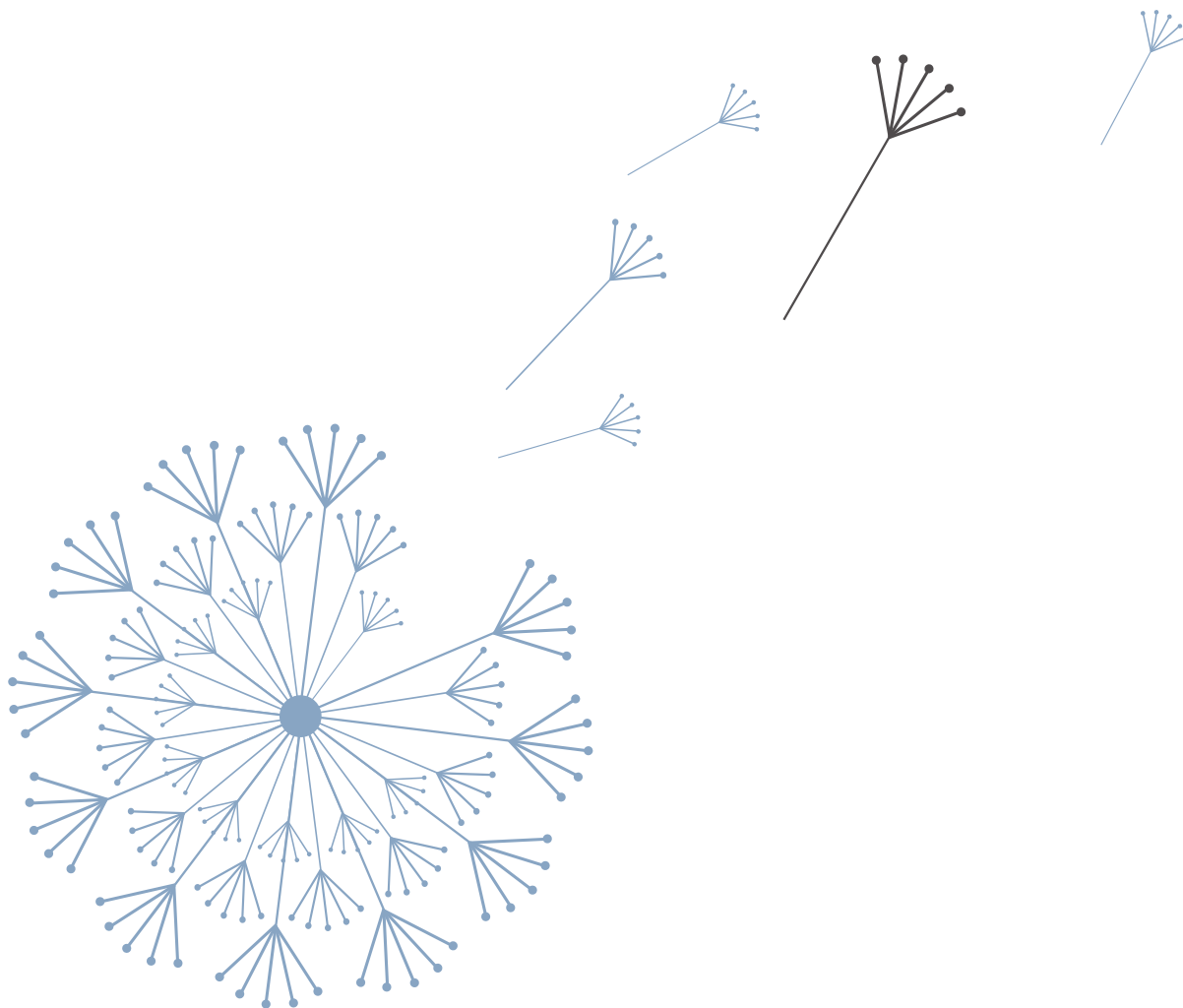
