WILL WORDING

"I give, devise and bequeath to the Royal Melbourne Hospital Neuroscience Foundation (ABN 25 741 608 900) of 300 Grattan Street, Parkville, Victoria, 3050, free from all taxes and duties, [specify your gift, eg. the sum of \$---]. I direct that the receipt of any trustee or other proper officer for the time being of that Foundation, will be a sufficient discharge to my Trustees who will not be bound to see its application. Without creating a binding obligation on my executor or the Royal Melbourne Hospital Neuroscience Foundation, I request that the Foundation use this bequest for the purpose of research in the field of [eg. brain tumour, stroke, epilepsy, dementia, Multiple Sclerosis, Parkinson's, Alzheimer's, movement disorders] and I request the Foundation to use these funds if at all practicable for this purpose or the purpose in its absolute discretion which most closely matches this purpose and failing that for the general purposes of the Royal Melbourne Hospital Neuroscience Foundation
