

GUACAMOLE WITCH DIP

This Halloween Guacamole Witch Dip will be the star attraction on your Halloween table. It's an easy appetizer recipe that's fun to make and comes together quickly. Yields: 4 - 6 servings | Total Time: 15 mins

Ingredients

- 1/2 small white onion 1 small jalapeño, finely chopped
- 2 lg avocados 1/4 cup cilantro, finely chopped
- Kosher salt & pepper 2 to 3 tbsp fresh lime juice

For Decorating: Blue corn tortilla chips, spiralized carrots, cornichon, radish slices,

stuffed olive slices, black olive pieces, small red pepper pieces, capers, and chives

Optional Additions: bread and butter pickles, coleslaw, chopped parsley

Directions:

Step 1 – In medium bowl, combine onion, jalapeño, cilantro, and ½ tsp each salt and pepper. Using the back of fork, lightly smash.


Step 2 - Add avocados and lime juice and mash to combine

Step 3 — Transfer guacamole to plate. Place tortilla chips at top of face to make hat and spiralized carrots around sides for hair. Add cornichon for nose and radish and stuffed olive slices for eyes; place black olive pieces above eyes for eyebrows. Add red pepper pieces for lips and capers and chives for hairy warts.
