Frame

Stationary portion of a window or door with three components: header across the top, jambs down each side and sill across the bottom.

Lite

Each area of glass is called a lite, and Infinity offers divided lite patterns to match the look of your home.

Panels

The operating and/or stationary portion of the door that holds the glass and is separate from the frame.

The horizontal part of a sash, door panel or screen.

Sash

The operating and/or stationary portion of the window that holds the glass and is separate from the frame.

Stile

The upright or vertical members of the framework of a sash, door, screen or other panel assembly.




During a full-frame installation project, the entire window and trim is removed and replaced. Full-frame replacement is also used for new window styles or enlarging your existing opening for a bigger view.
