Anything over these 10 minutes, even just one second over, will result in point deductions of **10 points per minute over**. Your talent piece must be family-friendly from music to dancing to costume and props.



Backstage Assistance

Each contestant is allowed ONE person to stay backstage in the dressing area to assist with costuming and prep. They MUST wear the provided badge it must be visible at all times. If there are any additional persons in the dressing area helping you, there is a **10-point deduction** per person.

RuCo Pride Pageant Royalty Contract

This contract is entered into by and between Incoming Royalty's Name (hereinafter referred to as "the Royalty") and Rutherford County Pride (hereinafter referred to as "the Pageant," "RuCo Pride," or "the Board"). By signing this contract, the Royalty agrees to fulfill the duties and responsibilities as outlined below during their reign.

1. Performance Requirements

The Royalty agrees to perform at RuCo Pride during the **2026 RuCo Pride Celebration** event and at any additional RuCo Pride-sponsored events as requested by the Board. Performances will be aligned with the values of the RuCo Pride community and will showcase the Royalty's talent, creativity, and support for LGBTQ+ advocacy.

Performance Expectations

1. The Royalty will perform at the scheduled annual event, **2026 RuCo Pride Celebration**, on Saturday, June 13th, 2026, and will coordinate with event staff and the Board regarding song choice(s), choreography, and stage requirements.
2. The royalty will perform at RuCo Pride-sponsored events throughout their reign, with dates and locations confirmed in advance.

2. Community Involvement & Charity Work

The Royalty agrees to commit to attending/completing at least **18** events in the RuCo Pride community during their reign. These events should focus on empowering the local community and support networks. (*There are **12** monthly meetings of the Board, and these will count toward the required **18** events if the Royalty is in attendance.*)

Charity/Community Service Expectations

1. As part of their **18** events, each member of the Royalty will organize or participate in at least **2** charity events during their reign, benefiting the community of Rutherford County. These may include fundraising performances, charity drives, volunteer work, or awareness campaigns.
2. The Royalty will actively promote these events through social media, public appearances, and community outreach, in collaboration with RuCo Pride's social media team and other local organizations.

3. Professional Conduct

Throughout the duration of their reign, the Royalty agrees to uphold the highest standards of professionalism, responsibility, and respect toward the Pageant and RuCo Pride, the LGBTQ+ community, sponsors, vendors, and event participants.



Behavior Expectations

1. The Royalty will act as a positive and inclusive representative of RuCo Pride and its values and mission.
2. The Royalty will maintain a respectful, uplifting, and inclusive presence in both in-person and online interactions. Social media/online interactions are subject to the RuCo Pride Social Media Policy.
3. The Royalty will attend all required events, rehearsals, meetings, and other engagements as requested by RuCo Pride unless a valid excuse is provided in advance.

Title/Reign Duration and Termination

Duration of Reign

The Royalty's title of **Mr./Ms. RuCo Pride 2026** shall be valid from **Saturday, June 13th, 2026** until the date of the next annual RuCo Pride Celebration (to be determined) OR until a successor is crowned.

Termination Agreement by Titleholder

This agreement may be terminated by the Royalty if they feel they are unable to fulfill their responsibilities outlined above. They must immediately notify the Board in writing, as soon as possible, of such. In such case, a replacement or acting titleholder may be named, solely at the discretion of the Board.

Termination Agreement by the Board

This agreement may be terminated by the Board if the Royalty has failed to meet the above-outlined responsibilities and expectations, including but not limited to attendance, community involvement, and/or adherence to RuCo Pride's standards of conduct.

1. Failure to engage in or support community services, charity events, RuCo Pride events, or other violations of this contract will result in a review of the Royalty's reign. The Board will have sole and final discretion to determine what, if any, action will be taken.
2. Failure to perform at the annual RuCo Pride Celebration or any required event detailed above may result in immediate termination of this contract, and a replacement or acting titleholder may be named, solely at the discretion of the Board.
