The post contains affiliate links; using them won't add any extra cost to your purchase. To make these heartwarming gifts, gather the following supplies: Kunin Classic Felt, Poly-Fil, Fabri-Fuse fabric glue, embroidery needle, threader, floss, cardstock, baker's twine, hole punch, corner rounder, and scissors. Start by cutting out two hearts from red and lagoon felt using the heart pattern. Then, cut out a hug shape from Kunin Classic Felt and attach it to the back of one of the hearts. Layer the plain heart on top of the hug heart, then use embroidery floss to blanket stitch around the heart. Stuff the heart with Poly-Fil, making sure to puff it up. Finish by closing the Easy Poly-Fil Pocket Hug with more stitching. Print and cut out the pocket hugs tags using the printable pattern. Use a corner rounder to soften the edges and punch a hole in the center of each tag. Loop baker's twine through the tag and arm of the hug, then secure it with a knot and finish with a bow. These quick and easy Pocket Hugs are perfect for beginners and can be made in no time. Share them with classmates, friends, or family members to spread love and kindness.
