This decision does not come easy as it can often make us feel that we've lost our independence or feel isolated from others. Here at the Township, we understand this transition, and this is why we created a transportation program for the seniors in our community.

We take seniors over the age of 60 to those essential appointments. The Transportation Program is a free program that runs Monday through Friday, 9AM to 4PM. We take seniors to doctor offices and other authorized non-medical locations. Please register today to start using our service.

Eligibility:

- Age 60 years of age and older
- Township residency
- · Ability to walk and enter/exit the vehicle unassisted
- Note that Township vehicles are NOT wheelchair accessible
- Clients are allowed 1 round trip per day




