The Proviso Public Partnership (PPP) plays an important role in supporting seniors in the Proviso Township community, who are facing mental health challenges. As many older adults experience isolation, grief, or conditions such as depression and anxiety, the PPP works to ensure they are not left to cope alone.

One of the key ways the organization helps is by connecting individuals to resources for social connection. Through wellness programs, and community gatherings, seniors are able to interact with peers, build friendships, and reduce feelings of loneliness. These connections are crucial, as isolation is one of the leading contributors to declining mental health among older adults.

The PPP also helps seniors access mental health resources and support services. By coordinating with local providers, they guide individuals toward counseling, support groups, and other forms of care that might otherwise feel out of reach. For many seniors, simply having someone help navigate these systems can make a significant difference in whether they receive the support they need.

In addition, the PPP promotes awareness and reduces stigma around mental health. By encouraging open conversations and providing education, the organization helps normalize seeking help and empowers seniors to prioritize their emotional well-being.

Through compassion, outreach, and community collaboration, the PPP ensures that seniors dealing with mental health issues are supported, connected, and valued—helping them maintain not only stability, but also a sense of purpose and belonging.

Adult Protective Services: We receive and investigate reports of abuse, neglect, and/or exploitation of older adults (60+) and disabled adults (18+).

Aging Well Neighborhood: Uniting older adults, businesses, and services for lifelong wellness, home aging support, chronic condition management, health education, and an age-friendly community.

Benefits Assistance: Trained staff and volunteers help older adults access entitled benefits and services.

Caregiver Support: Offering counseling, support groups, and respite care for those caring for older adults.

Chore Housekeeping: A monthly/bi-monthly program to assist with personal care and housekeeping tasks that can also help to meet necessary transportation needs.

Congregate Meals: Socialization and nutritious meals for older adults (60+) in a congregate setting, for a suggested donation.

Grandparents Raising Grandchildren: Support groups, counseling, education, and resources for grandparents raising grandchildren.

Housing Assistance: Person-centered services to preserve housing and prevent homelessness for older adults.

Home Repair: Minor repairs and modifications for older individuals to stay at home safely and comfortably.

Information and Assistance: We provide comprehensive info about local, state & federal resources essential to older adults & their family.

Options Counseling: Long-term care education, decision support, and assistance with enrolling in public programs.

Transitional Care: Linkages and expedited support for clients returning home from healthcare facilities, helping prevent unnecessary institutionalization.

Transportation Assistance: We connect older adults to transportation services that meet their needs and are appropriate for their limitations.
