Curv-A-Tech Corporation – WARRANTY

Curv-A-Tech Corporation warrants to the original purchaser that all its products will be free from defects in materials and workmanship for a period of three (3) years from the date of shipment from the Curv-A-Tech manufacturing plant. Proof of purchase is required for this warranty to be valid.

This warranty applies only to Curv-A-Tech products that are installed and maintained in accordance with Curv-A-Tech's corporate recommendations, installation instructions, and accepted industry standards. It covers only defects that appear within the three-year warranty period and only if Curv-A-Tech is notified within sixty (60) days after the defect is discovered or should reasonably have been discovered.

Failure to notify Curv-A-Tech within this time period will automatically release the company from any responsibility and/or liability under this limited warranty.

Curv-A-Tech products are tested in accordance with Miami-Dade County Code requirements. However, certain conditions may occur during tropical storms, hurricanes, or tornadoes that exceed these standards.

Caulking may be used in some installations to seal the frame or trim against water or air penetration. Caulking is not considered part of the Curv-A-Tech product and is therefore not covered under this warranty. Responsibility for caulking rests with the installer or homeowner.

Curv-A-Tech warrants insulated glass against stress cracks for a period of one (1) year from the date of shipment. This warranty excludes imperfections, scratches, reflected distortions from tempering, or distortions caused during the heat-strengthening process, as these are considered normal and are not covered.

This warranty also covers standard ESP paint finishes for a period of three (3) years from shipment, provided the finish does not blister or peel. However, this warranty is not valid for products installed within three (3) miles of saltwater bodies. In such cases, the warranty period is limited to one (1) year.

Maintenance Requirements

Hardware must be kept clean and free of debris and must be lubricated at least every six (6) months. Aluminum, glass, and all weatherstripping should be cleaned periodically with a mild soap solution and a soft cloth.

Products installed within one (1) mile of high-salinity areas or coastlines should receive maintenance at half the normal interval listed above. Products installed on waterfront properties may require even more frequent maintenance depending on site conditions such as blowing sand or saltwater spray.
