

# St Thomas Baby Quilt

## Supplies:

- Cotton fabric in 2 coordinating bright, cheerful baby colors
- Lightweight batting 21"x21"

## Cutting Instructions:

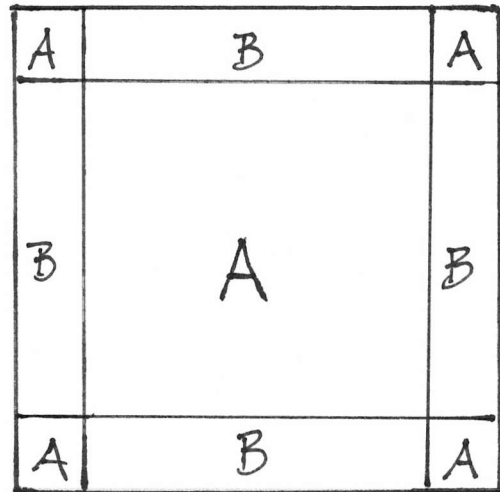
### - Color A:

- 14-1/2" x 14-1/2" square for quilt top (cut 1)
- 3-1/2" x 3-1/2" corner squares (cut 4)

### - Color B:

- 3-1/2" x 14-1/2" border strip (cut 4)
- 20-1/2" x 20-1/2" backing (cut 1)

**Finished Size:** 20" x 20"



**General Instructions:** Use 1/4" seams when sewing all pieces.

## **Assembly Instructions:**

Pin 2 "B" border strips to opposite sides of the 14-1/2" quilt top square (Color A). Sew, press toward center.

Pin 1 "A" corner square to the ends of the other two "B" boarder strips; sew, press toward center.

Pin sewn border strips to the top and bottom edge of the quilt top, matching the seams. Sew. Press the entire quilt top.

Place quilt batting on bottom, place cut backing right side up on top of the batting. And place the sewn quilt top right side facing backing. Pin all three layers together and sew leaving a 4" opening to turn. Trim corners and edges. Pull inside through opening between top and backing/batting.

Top stitch around the entire quilt close to the edge to close the opening. Choose your quilting design securing quilt center with stitching. Sew a label on the corner of the quilt—folding in the cut ends of the label so no raw edges are visible.
