## **Bunting Wrap**

This simple bunting in three sizes wraps prettily around a dead infant for presentation to family, photos, and burial. Many, many bereaved mothers have expressed the need to remember their babies looking beautiful and well cared-for.

Nurses say this bunting makes it easy to make tiny ones look attractive peeking out of a lacy, snuggly wrap.

## **CUTTING AND FABRIC:**

Use printed flannel for lining. (For the large size, you might use fleece for more body)
Use solid fabric for outside. (I usually use flannel).

Optional for large size: One small Velcro fastener


Cut outside and lining together with RIGHT sides facing OUT.

Mark ribbon placement, center bottom, and overlaps on right side of outside fabric.


## SEWING:

- Keep outside and lining pinned together, and sew as one piece.
   Sew both layers together using a wide ziz-zag up one side, across the top, and down the other side.
- 2, Sewing through both layers (ok, you don't have a choice now), sew lace casing to the outside.
- 3. Apply lace edging to sides and top using a zig-zag or decorative stitch. Gather lace slightly at curves.
- 4. Attach Threads of Love label











5. Place on table RIGHT side up.
Fold left and right sides to center, matching the bottom center mark to the overlap marks.

Left is over right for girl Right over left for boy. Pin at center bottom.




6. Make a small inverted pleat at each side of the bottom: '4" for mini, '4" for small, '4" for large. Pin pleats down.



7. Sew across bottom with ¼" allowance. Trim close to sewing, and finish edge with zig-zag.



8. Turn right side out. Thread ribbon through casing, tacking it with a few stitches at center back.



OPTIONAL for large size: place a Velcro fastener 3 1/2 inches below ribbon casing. Rough 3ide facing up SOFT side facing down-towards the baby

9. Tie ribbon and fold the top back an inch, making It look like a pretty collar.
