

Knitted Easy & Elegant Stitches for Kangaroo Blankets

Threads of Love

Please use 3-ply Acrylic Baby Yarn, or 4-ply Soft Acrylic Yarns. Use knitting needles size 5 for the smaller yarns, and up to a size 8 for the fuller yarns. Optimal size for Kangaroo blankets is 18" to 20" square. The knitter will need to figure the number to cast on according to the pattern chosen and the size of her yarn and needles.

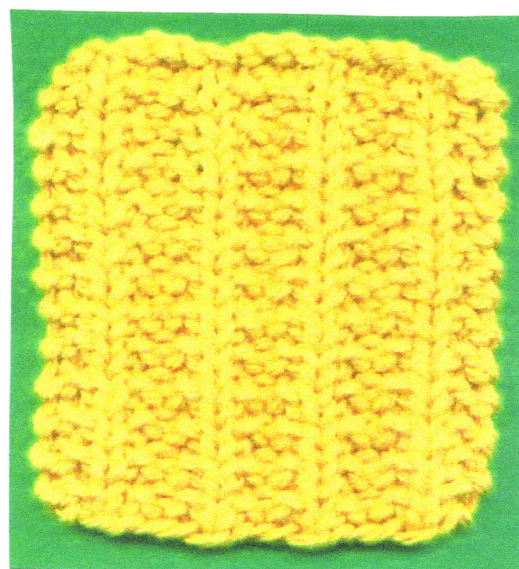
SEED RIB

CO # multiples of 4 +1

Row 1: K2, *P1, K3; rep from * to last 3 sts, end P1, K2

Row 2: P1, *K3, P1; rep from *

Repeat rows 1 and 2 for desired length



BASKETWEAVE

CO # multiples of 10

Row 1: Knit

Rows 2,4,6: *K6, P4*, repeat

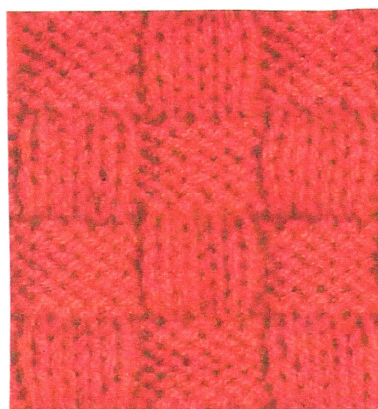
Rows 3 & 5: *K4, P6*, repeat

Row 7: Knit

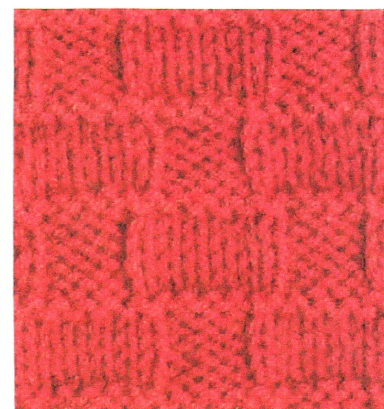
Rows 8, 10, 12: *P4, K6*, repeat

Rows 9 & 11: *P6, K4*, repeat

Repeat rows 1 through 12 for desired length



Right Side



Wrong Side

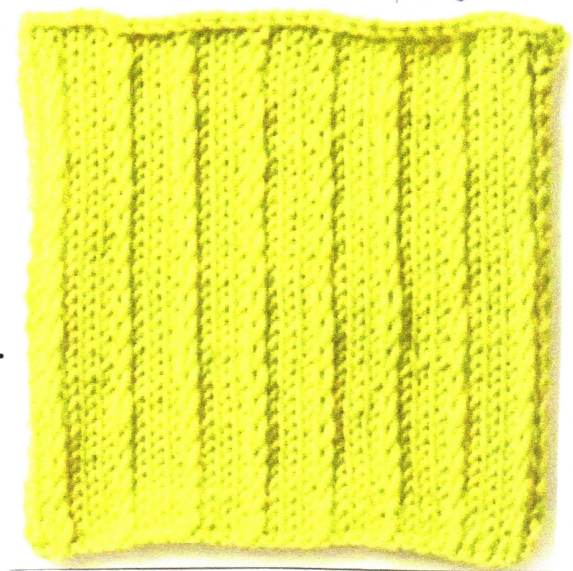
SIMPLE SLIP STRIPE

CO # multiples of 4 + 3

Row 1 (right side): K1, *sl 1, K3: rep from *, end sl 1, K1.

Row 2: Purl across row.

Repeat rows 1 and 2



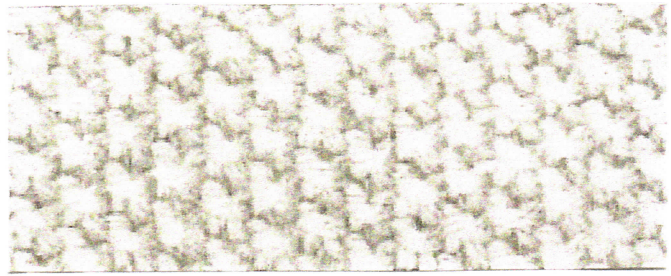
SEED STITCH

CO Even # of stitches

Row 1: *K1, P1*, repeat to end

Row 2: *P1, K1* repeat to end

Repeat rows 1 and 2



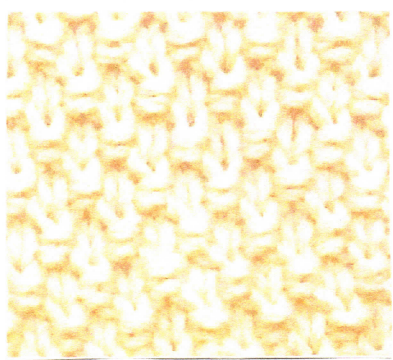
DOUBLE SEED STITCH or MOSS STITCH

CO Even # of stitches

Rows 1 & 2: *K1, P1*, repeat to end

Rows 3 & 4: * P1, K1*, repeat to end

Repeat rows 1 through 4



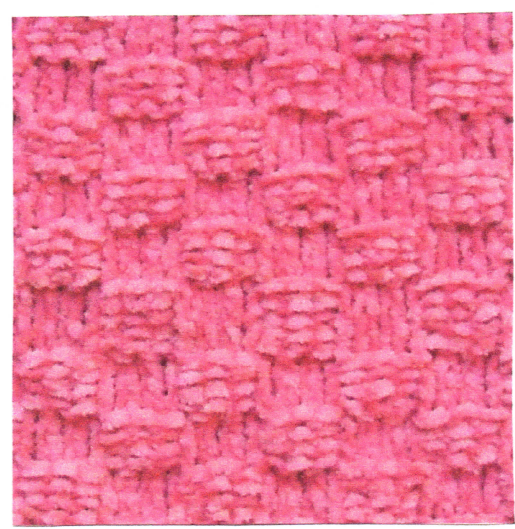
CLOSE CHECKS

CO multiples of 6, or multiples of 6 + 3

Rows 1 – 4: *P3, K3*, repeat to end

Rows 5 – 8: *K3, P3*, repeat to end

Repeat rows 1 through 8



SINGLE CHEVRON

CO multiples of 8

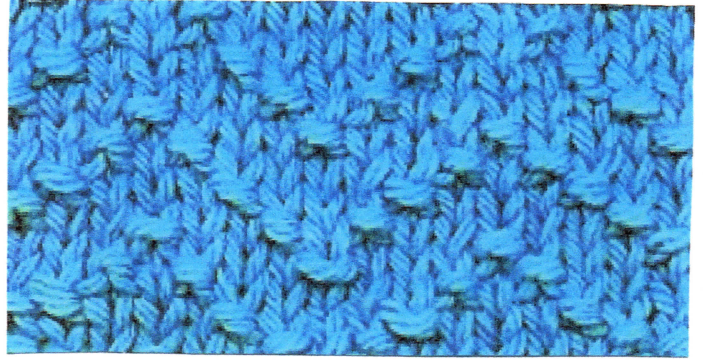
Row 1 (right side): *P1, K3*, repeat to end

Row 2: *K1, P5, K1, P1*, repeat to end

Row 3: *K2, P1, K3, P1, K1*, repeat to end

Row 4: *P2, K1, P1, K1, P3*, repeat to end

Repeat rows 1 through 4



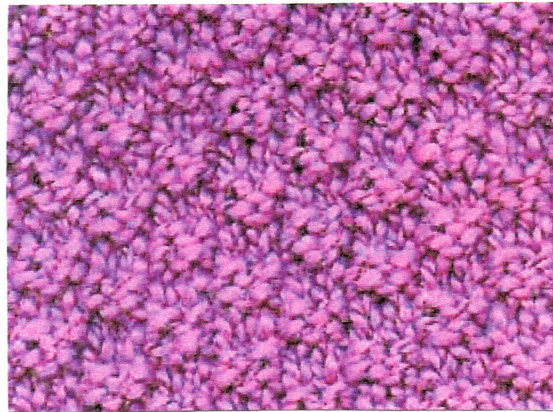
DOUBLE MOSS STITCH

CO multiples of 4

Rows 1 & 2: *K2, P2*, repeat to end

Rows 3 & 4: *P2, K2*, repeat to end

Repeat rows 1 through 4



MOCK CABLE STITCH

CO multiples of 10

Row 1: *P4, K1, P1, K4*, repeat to end

Row 2: *P3, K2, P2, K3*, repeat to end

Row 3: *P2, K2, P1, K1, P2, K2*, repeat to end

Row 4: *P1, K2, P2, K2, P2, K1*, repeat to end

Row 5: *K2, P3, K3, P2*, repeat to end

Row 6: *K1, P4, K4, P1*, repeat

Repeat rows 1 through 6



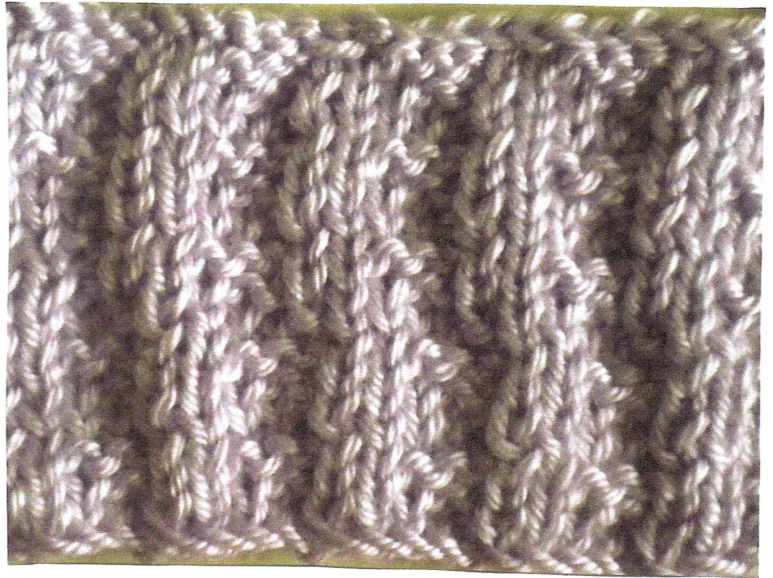
HURDLE

CO even # of stitches

Rows 1 & 2: K across

Rows 3 & 4: K1, P1 across

Repeat rows 1 through 4



FANCY

CO odd # of stitches

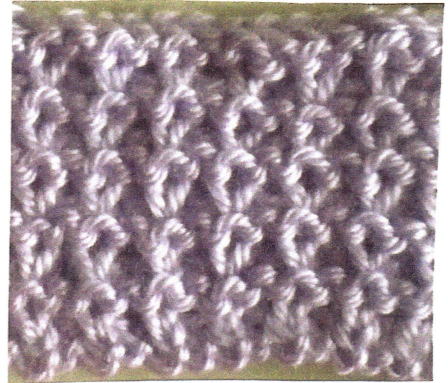
Row 1: K across

Row 2: K1, *yarn in back, Sl 1 as if to P, K1*, repeat

Row 3: K1, *yarn in front, Sl 1 as if to P, K1*, repeat

Row 4: K across

Repeat rows 2 through 4



DIVIDED BOXES

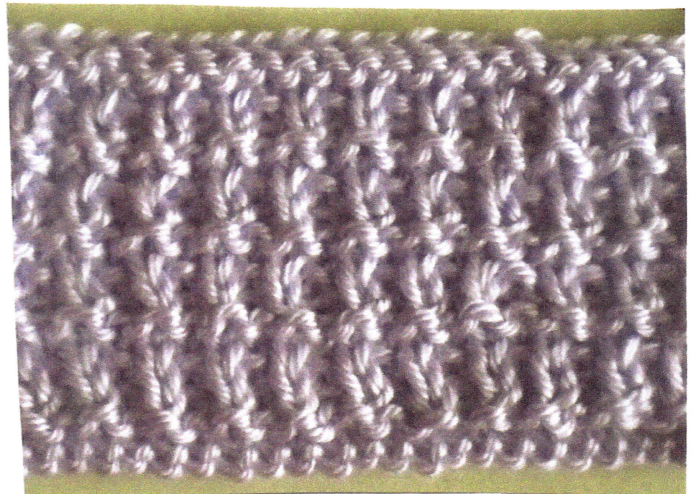
CO multiples of 5 stitches

Row 1: K across (right side or work)

Row 2: *K1, P4*, across

Rows 3 & 4: *K3, P2*, across

Repeat rows 2 through 4



FARROW RIB

CO multiples of 3 stitches + 1

Row 1: *K2, P1* to last st, K1

Row 2: P1, *K2, P1*, across

Repeat rows 1 and 2



HORIZONTAL DASH STITCH

CO multiples of 10 stitches + 6

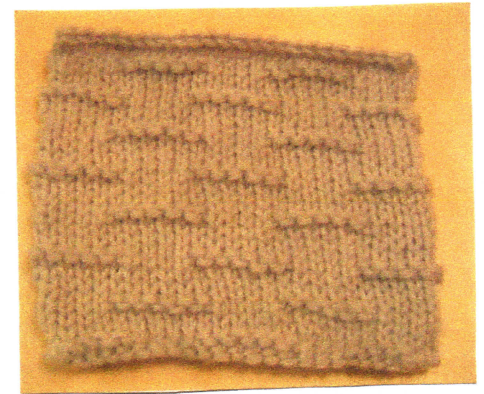
Row 1: P6, *K4, P6*, across

Rows 2, 4, 6 & 8: P across

Rows 3 & 7: K across

Row 5: P1, *K4, P6*, until 5 sts remain, K4, P1

Repeat rows 1 through 8



SLIP STITCH HONEYCOMB

CO Odd # of stitches

Rows 1 & 3: (right side) K across

Row 2: K1, *slip 1 with yarn in back, K1*, across

Row 4: K2, *slip 1 with yarn in back, K1*, across, end w K1

Repeat rows 1 through 4



BROKEN RIB

CO multiples of 2 + 1 Row 1: K across

Row 2: P1, *K1, P1*, across. Repeat rows 1 and 2
