The scheduling of medical appointments or reservations may be made up to fourteen (14) days in advance of the trip date. Same day requests will be honored if scheduling permits. Reservation for next day service can be made 24 hours a day by calling 804-324-5658. If you receive an answering service leave a message and someone will return your call the next day of service.

Confirmation will be made the same day or morning of the next regular business day. The paratransit service is available 5:45 am until 8:15 pm Monday thru Friday and 5:45 am

until 8:15 pm Saturday.



“Customers are not required to live inside the Fixed route service area; however, all customer trips must be within 3-quarters of a mile outside the service area and end within the PAT paratransit service area, and customers must board and disembark the paratransit vehicle inside of the service area at a safe transfer location.

Transfer points will be established with customers traveling outside the service area.
