## Tuition Payment Options

Payments can be made online via the **FACTS** Tuition Management web site at <https://online.factsmgt.com/signin/3G2W5>. Payments can also be made in person to our business office during normal school hours.

There is a 15 day grace period for all payment options.

<b>Annual Payment</b> (one installment)	<b>\$100 discount.</b> Payment due August 1
<b>Semi-annual payment plan</b> (two installments)	<b>\$50 discount.</b> Payment due August 1 and January 1
<b>Monthly payment plan</b> (twelve installments)	<b>Due on the 1st of each month</b> starting June 1 (number of payments will be adjusted to 11 or 10 if registered after June)

Note: If for any reason your daughter is withdrawn from school, all tuition and fees must be current and paid in full prior to the release of any transcripts.
