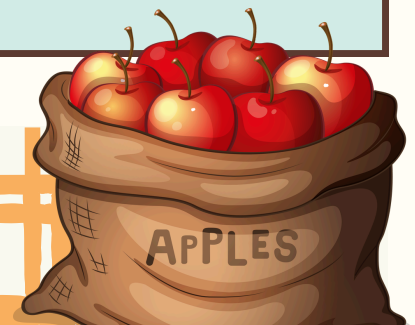


Fall 2025 Field Trips



🍏 Trip to the Organic Apple Farm

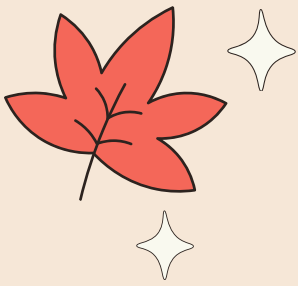

Field Trips

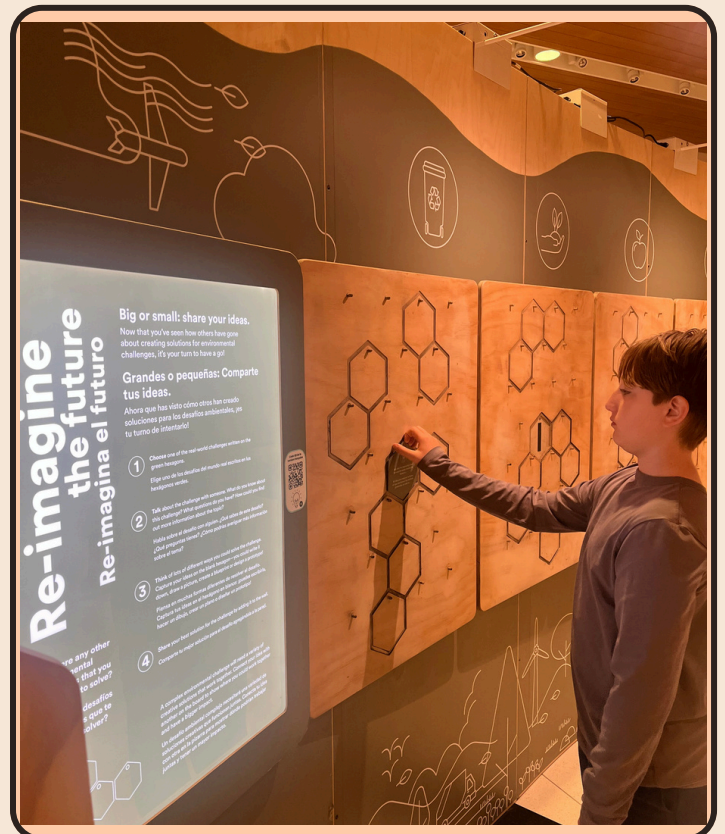
Library 3D Printing Workshop

Ontario Science Centre Field Trip

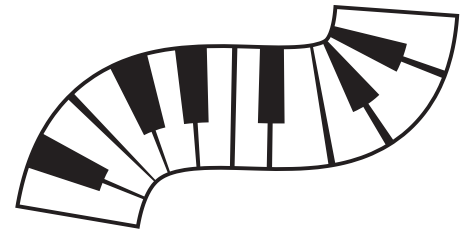

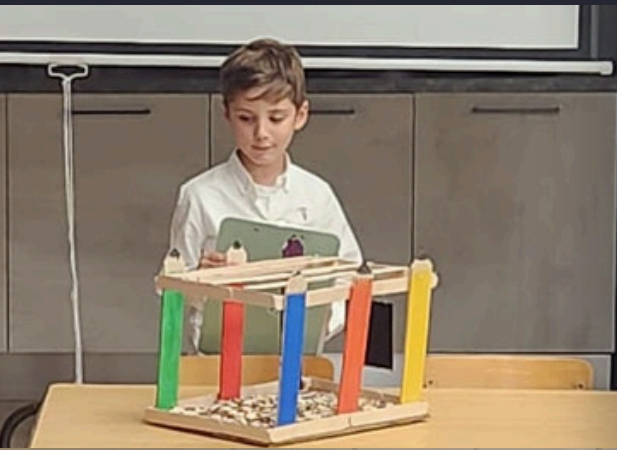
