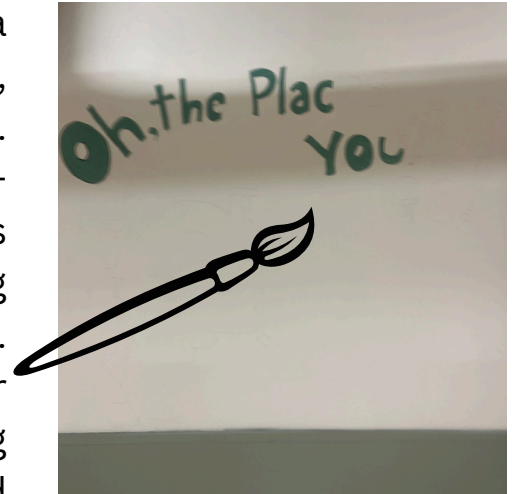
Exclusive Skating Lessons

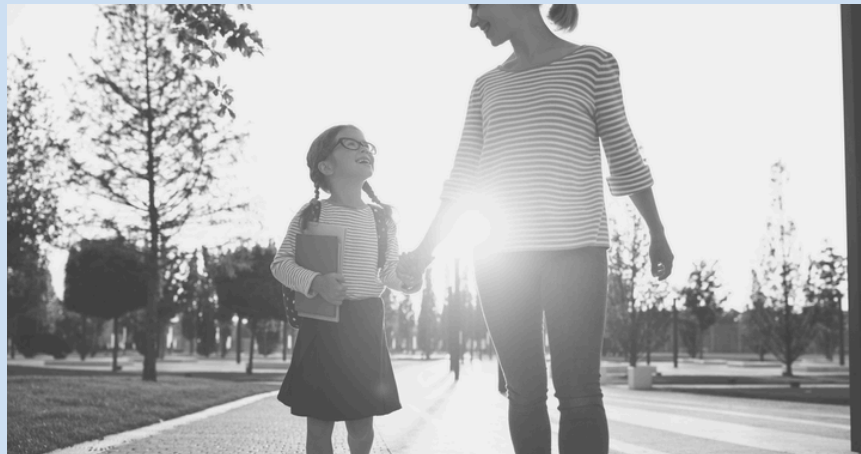

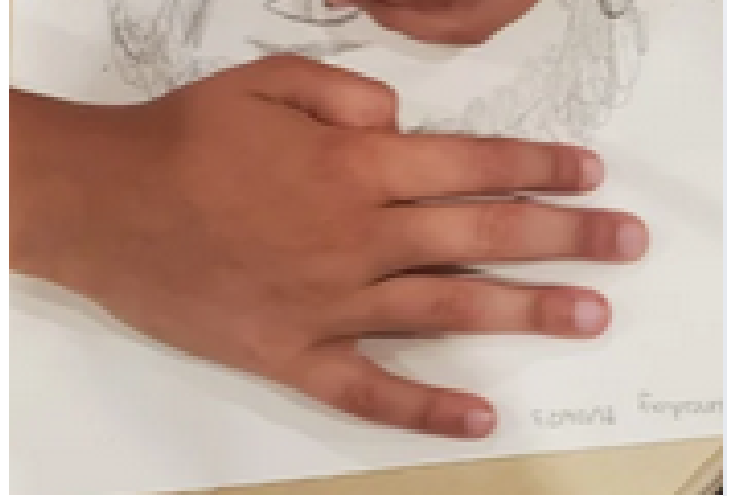

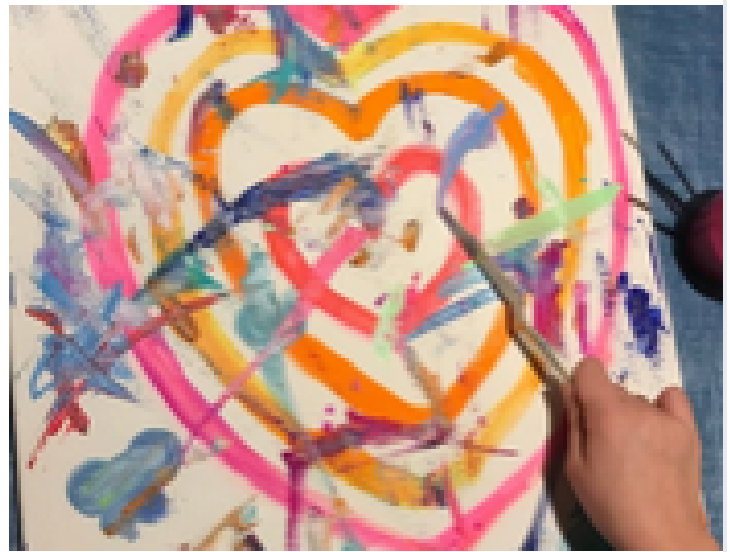
